

BRACKET PREPARATION



Insert the M8 knurled stud into the awning bracket in the direction shown.

Place the M10 washer over the stud and then install a M8 flange nut onto the stud.



Place the bracket into a vice. Tighten the M8 nut against the washer to pull the knurled stud into the bracket.

Continue to tighten the nut until the back of the knurled stud is home against the back of the bracket.


Complete this step on each of the brackets requiring a stud.



INSTALLATION PROCEDURE



Remove the 2 capscrews securing the roof rack to the mounting bracket.



Install the awning mounting bracket between the roof rack and the roof rack mount at the front and rear of the rack.

Re install the capscrews into the roof rack mount ensuring that they pass through the awning mount but do not tighten fully.



In some installations, the awning bracket may overhang the roof rack support bracket. For these installations install 2 x M8 x 20 capscrews and M8 nyloc nuts with flat washers under each to the 2 outermost holes in the awning bracket and roof rack to add extra support.



If installing brackets onto a 6 mount rack install the spacer plate provided to the centre rack mount.



Measure centre pitch on awning mount brackets.



Install awning brackets onto awning and set at the required pitch taken from the previous step.

Position brackets so that the awning will sit in the desired location on vehicle when installed.

Fasten using fasteners supplied with the awning. Positioin fasteners diagonally opposite each other as shown.

Tighten to the specified torque.



Install 1 M8 flange nut loosely onto each knurled stud.

Place the awning onto the mounts by passing the M8 nut through the key hole on the roof mount and sliding down to the bottom of the slot.

Secure the awning to the roof mount by tightening the M8 nut to the specified torque.

Position the awning in the desired location by sliding the roof mount in and out.

Retighten roof rack mounts to the specified torque.

To remove awning, loosen M8 flange nuts and lift awning up and away from vehicle. Awning mount brackets will remain attached to vehicle.
