



ALIGN CUT OUT IN MOUNTING PLATE

WITH VEHICLE EXHAUST PIPE

1) Insert nut plate into frame. Align hole in frame with nut plate.

- 2) Raise the hitch into position. Loosely attach hitch to frame at mounting locations near the bumper with the 1/2" hex bolts provided. Use 7/16" hex bolts in remaining fastener locations as shown.
- 3) Torque all 7/16" fasteners to 70 lb.-ft. and all 1/2" fasteners to 110 lb.-ft.
