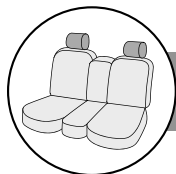

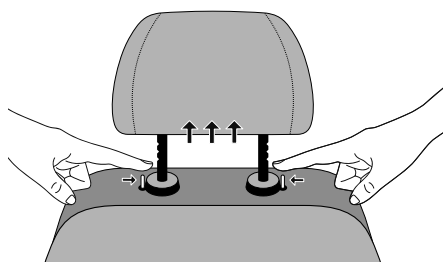

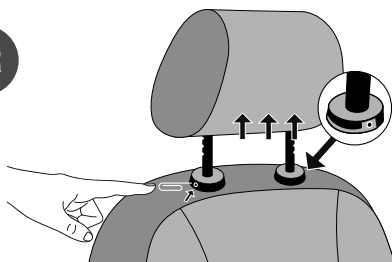


1 REMOVE ALL HEADRESTS (IF APPLICABLE)



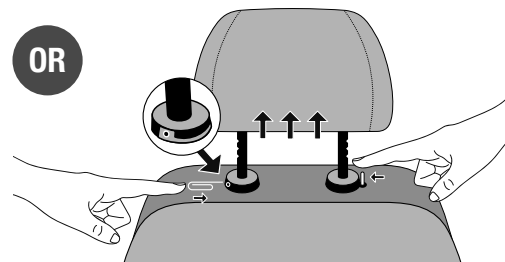
A. Push in side release buttons

OR

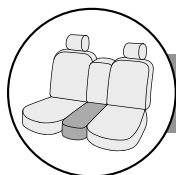


B. Pin holes on headrest
Insert a paper-clip end into the hole.

C. Some may have both.



2A CUSHION COVER for 20 section NO storage compartment

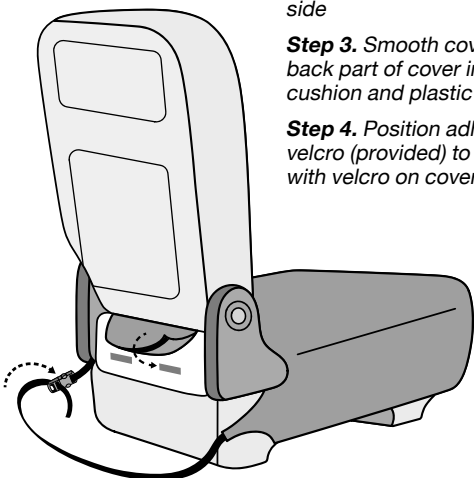
UNCLIP THE BUCKLES BEFORE INSTALLING

Step 1. Center cover on seat

Step 2. Pass side strap around the back and buckle to other side

Step 3. Smooth cover and tuck back part of cover in between cushion and plastic molding

Step 4. Position adhesive velcro (provided) to align with velcro on cover



OR

Step 1. For easier access to the center portion, move both driver and passenger to most forward position

Step 2. Undo seat belt buckle from elastic loop on seat

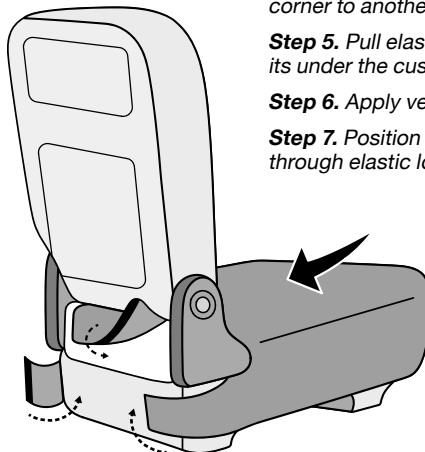
Step 3. Center cover on seat

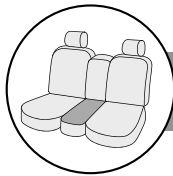
Step 4. Place front elastic on cover between cushion and organizer starting from one corner to another

Step 5. Pull elastic down making sure its under the cushion at front

Step 6. Apply velcro on cover to carpet at back of seat

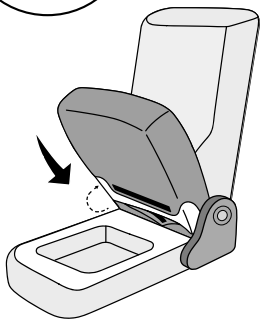
Step 7. Position seat belt buckle through elastic loop on seat cover

CUSHION COVER for 20 section WITH storage compartment



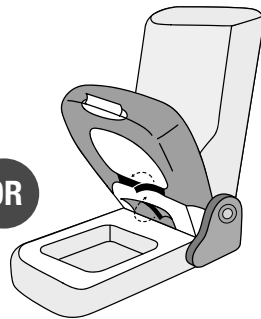
Step 1. Open cushion/lid

Step 2. Slip cover over cushion/lid

Step 3. Pass back flap through crevice

Step 4. Attach velcro at bottom of cover

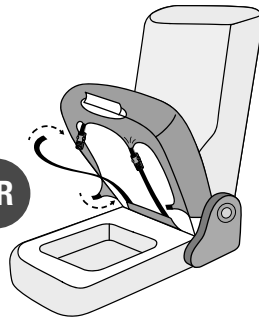
Step 2. Slip cover over cushion/lid

Step 4. Adhere velcro on flap to carpeting under lid

Step 5. Pull side velcro pieces under lid and attach together

Step 3. Tuck straps under lid and attach to buckles

Step 4. Pull side velcro pieces under lid and adhere to carpet

Step 5. Adjust straps and velcro to equalize tension

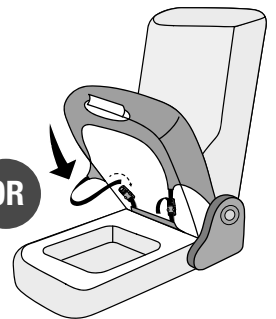

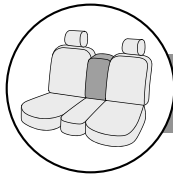

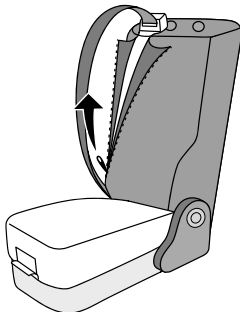
Step 3. Tuck back part of cushion cover through crevice

BACKREST COVER for 20 sections for seats with built in seatbelts

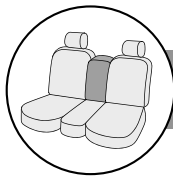


Step 1. Open zipper

Step 2. Slip cover over backrest/armrest

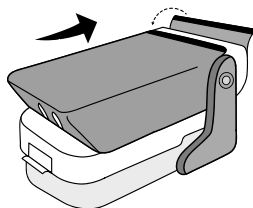
Step 3. Ensure cover is installed under seat belt strap

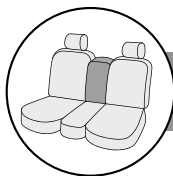
BACKREST COVER for 20 sections NO storage and NO cupholders



Step 1. Slip cover over backrest/armrest

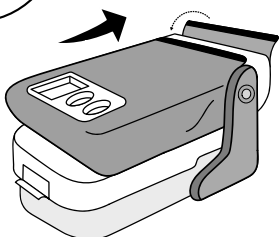
Step 2. Pass flap through crevice

BACKREST COVER for 20 sections NO storage and WITH cupholders

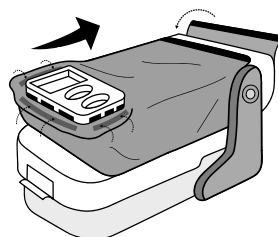


Step 1. Slip cover over backrest/armrest

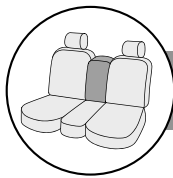

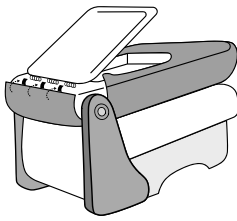

BACKREST COVER for 20 sections WITH storage and NO cupholders



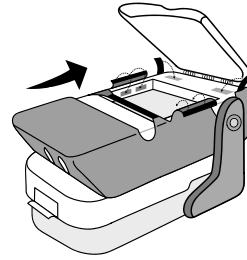
Step 1. Open storage compartment

Step 4. Position adhesive back velcro (provided) to line up with velcro on the cover

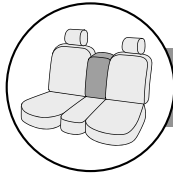

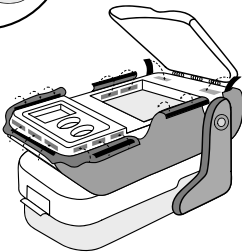
Step 2. Slip cover over backrest/armrest

BACKREST COVER for 20 sections WITH storage and WITH cupholders



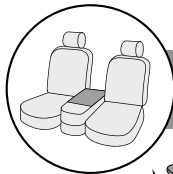
Step 1. Open storage compartment

Step 3. Snug cover at the back so velcro attached to cover can be positioned through the crevice where hinges are located

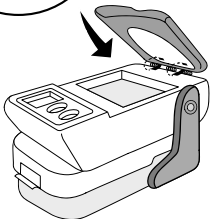
Step 4. Position adhesive back velcro (provided) to inside of storage compartment to align with the velcro tabs on cover

Step 5. Position adhesive back velcro (provided) around the edge of the cup holders to line up with velcro on the cover

LID COVER for 20 sections storage compartment



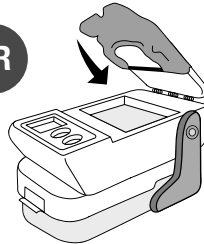
Step 1. Open storage compartment

Step 2. Slip cover over lid

Step 3. Pull velcro tabs on cover around the hinges on the side

Step 4. Position adhesive back velcro (provided) on underside of lid to align with the velcro tabs on cover and attach

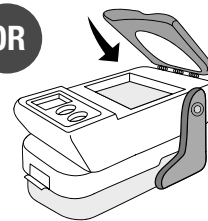

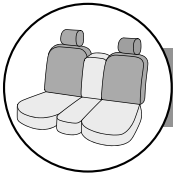

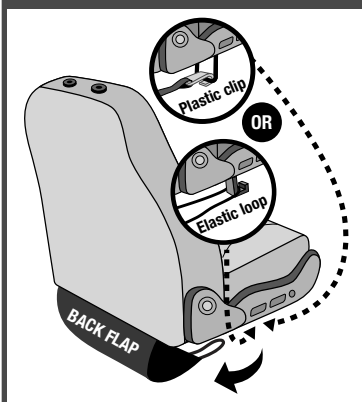

BACKREST COVER for 40 sections

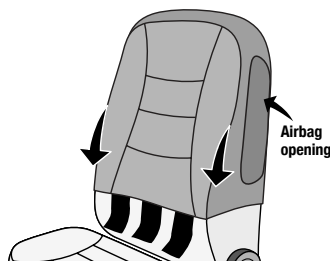
▼ IN THIS INSTALLATION THE BACK FLAP ATTACHED TO THE SEAT CANNOT BE REMOVED.

▼ SEAT WITH THE BACK FLAPS ATTACHED

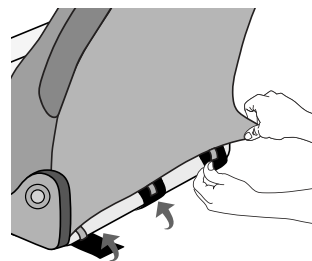
NOTE 1



IN SOME APPLICATIONS, THE BACK FLAP ON THE SEAT CAN BE RELEASED EITHER BY UNHOOKING THE ELASTIC LOOP OR BY REMOVING THE PLASTIC CLIP UNDERNEATH THE SEAT.

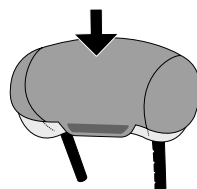


Step 1. Slip the cover over the backrest, ensuring the side airbag opening is on the door side

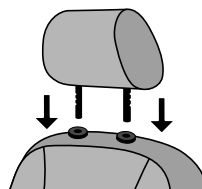


Step 2. Tuck carpet strips through the crevice and attach to Velcro at back

Step 3. Slip cover over backrest. With seat in most upright position, pass back straps through crevice. Then feed straps under seat and buckle to front of cushion cover

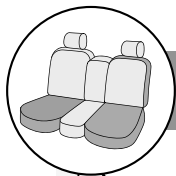


Step 4. Slip on headrest cover. Attach velcro



Step 5. Replace headrest

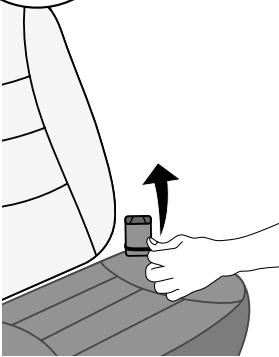




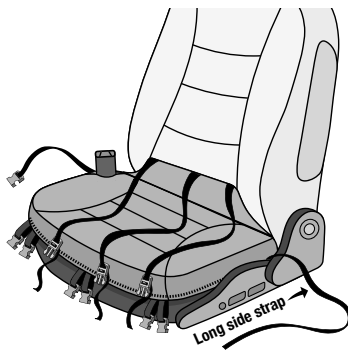

CUSHION COVER for 40 section

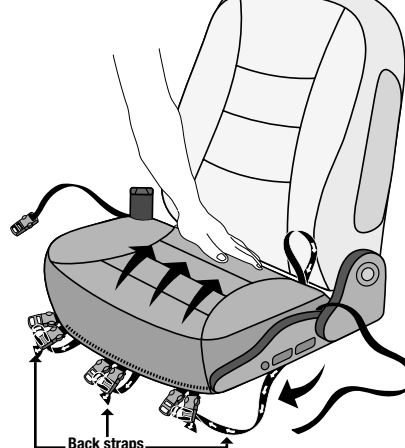
UNCLIP THE BUCKLES BEFORE INSTALLING



Step 1. Release seat belt buckle from elastic holder (if applicable).

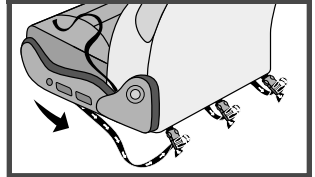


Step 2. Place cover on seat cushion ensuring that the washing label is to the inside and the long side strap is on the door side.

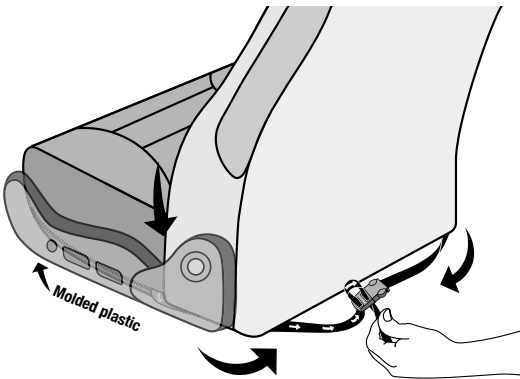


Step 3. With seat in most upright position, pass the straps sewn on the back of the cushion cover through the crevice. Feed straps under the seat and buckle to front of cushion cover.

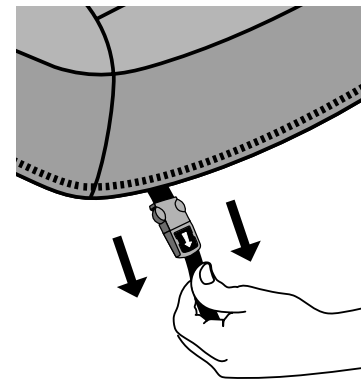
SOME CUSHION COVER STRAPS FEED FROM THE FRONT, UNDER THE SEAT AND BUCKLE AT THE BACK.



Step 4. Release the side straps from buckle before installing. Replace strap after installation.



Step 5. Adjust cover for better fit.



Step 6. Adjust buckles and straps to equalize tension.

SEATS WITH INTEGRATED SEAT AIRBAGS MUST BE COVERED ONLY WITH SEAT COVERS DESIGNED WITH OPENINGS THAT WILL NOT INTERFERE WITH THE DEPLOYMENT. NEVER INSTALL SEAT COVERS WITHOUT THESE OPENINGS AS THIS MAY INTERFERE WITH THE PROPER DEPLOYMENT OF THE AIR BAGS AND COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
