

  Begin by removaling the factory ging leasenship, Remove and save the four 10mm hex head bolts attaching the upper tabs to the core support mounts. Lift up gently on the tabs and pull outward of the factory bumper.

  Now remove the factory bumper by unbotting the eight 1/4mm hex head outs (4 per side) attaching the bumper to the frame, save for reuse with the Alumili STEP 8. step. Align brackets making sure they are level, then snug the factory parking sensors (if equipped) from the stock bumper. Remove retaining clip from the backside of the bumper and slide sensor out through the front of the bumper. Transfer over to the new Alumilite Bumper reusing the factory mounting hardware in the reverse order in which they were removed, if not equipped with sensors install the provided plugs into the senor holes in the Alumilite bumper. Now is also a good time to install the RT bar if desired.
- STEP 9. bumper. Place the plastic insulators (100298) over the T-bolts so that when the bumper is installed, they are between the bumper and brackets. This will isolate the aluminum and steel parts. Carefully slide the bumper onto the BP5182 brackets on the frame and align the T-Bolts with the slots in the brackets. Attach using the supplied M12 flat washers, lock washers, and hex head nuts. Carefully align the bumper from side to side and up and down. Once you are satisfied with the fit tighten all M12 hardware. Next fully tighten the eight factory 14mm hex head nuts to the frame. If equipped, Plug in parking sensor harness into sensors and check for proper function, if not use provided plastic plugs to fill holes.
- STEP 10. If you are installing lights into your new bumper, do so now into the mounting tab locations provided in the bumper and wire to the manufacture's specifications. ICI recommends that you re-torque all mounting hardware after 50-100 miles of driving. Enjoy your new ALUMILITE BUMPER!
