# **Safety Information:**

**Warning:** Do not work under a vehicle supported only by a jack. Place support stands securely under the vehicle in the manufacturer's specified locations unless otherwise instructed.

Proper use of safety equipment and eye/face/hand protection is necessary when performing any of the following instructions.

We strive for an exceptional experience for all our valued customers. If for any reason you need assistance with your Belltech products, please do not return the product to the store you purchased from, but rather call our dedicated customer service experts, from 7am to 5pm PST.

We recommend that a qualified mechanic, in a properly equipped facility, perform this installation.

It is very helpful to have an assistant available during installation.

# **Before Driving Your Vehicle:**

It is important to double check all brake hoses, cables, and other components to be sure there is no interference. You must also check for wheel/tire to chassis/body interference. If any issues are found, review your installation instructions to be sure no steps were missed, and any problems are corrected.

Make sure your vehicle is aligned immediately following installation.

Check all hardware and torque at intervals for the first 10, 100, and 1000 miles.

Some of Belltech's products are designed to improve your vehicle's off-road performance. Leveling/lifting your vehicle may result in an altered center of gravity. It is crucial to use extreme care when operating your vehicle to prevent rollover and/or loss of control.

Any changes in your vehicle's suspension may result in transformed handleability. Please test-drive your vehicle in a remote location so you can become accustomed to the revised driving characteristics.

Perform headlight check and adjustment.

Failure to drive any modified vehicle in a safe manner may result in harm or death.

Never operate your modified vehicle under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or lack of adequate sleep.

Always wear your seatbelt.







#### **RECOMMENDED TOOLS:**

- Properly rated floor jack
- Support stands
- Wheel chocks

- Torque wrench rated up to 150 ft lbs.

### **JACKING, SUPPORTING, AND PREPARING THE VEHICLE**

- Park your vehicle on a smooth, level, concrete, or seasoned asphalt surface.
- Block the front wheels of the vehicle using wheel chocks. Make sure the vehicle's transmission is in "PARK" (automatic) or first gear (manual).
- 3. Activate the parking brake.
- Loosen, but do not remove, the rear wheel lug nuts.
- Lift the rear of the vehicle off the ground using a properly rated floor jack. Lift the vehicle so the rear tires are approximately 6-8 inches off the ground.
- Place support stands rated for the vehicle's weight. The stands must be positioned in the factory specified locations. (Refer to the owner's manual). Prior to lowering the vehicle onto stands, make sure the support stands will contact the chassis. It is very important that the vehicle is properly supported to prevent any harm to oneself or to the vehicle.
- Lower the vehicle slowly onto the stands.
- Remove the rear wheels.



Never work under a vehicle supported only by a jack. It is necessary to place support stands securely under the vehicle in the manufacturer's specified locations unless otherwise instructed.

#### **VEHICLES WITHOUT A FACTORY REAR SWAY BAR**


9. To prepare the U-bolts, trim 3/8" on one side of both U-bolts.



- 10. If the vehicle is equipped with shock extensions, please remove please before installing the Belltech sway bar.
- 11. Thoroughly lubricate the inside of the supplied pivot bushings using the grease packet included with the kit.
- 12. Place the bushings on both sides of the Belltech sway bar, centered on the first set of bends. Once located, rotate the bushings slightly to evenly spread the lubricant. Place the bushing brackets over the bushings.



13. Ensure there is 1/32" to 1/16" of the bushing is showing after the bracket is seated. If the bushing is showing more than 1/16", use a sander or a sheet of coarse grit sandpaper to shave it down to the proper height.




#### **VEHICLES WITHOUT A FACTORY REAR SWAY BAR**

14. The U-clamps will be placed through the shock mounts with the trimmed side of U-bolt inside the shock mount.



15. Carefully bend the hydraulic line away from the axle and place the U-bolts over the axle tube and under the brake line, ensuring the brake line is not clamped underneath. Place the U-clamp on the U-bolt followed by the support plate. Mount the sway bar and bushing bracket on the U-clamp. Hand tighten the supplied nuts on the U-bolt for now. Ensure the sway bar is positioned below the axle.





#### **VEHICLES WITH A FACTORY REAR SWAY BAR**

16. Note the position of the original sway bar on the rear axle to help with the installation of the Belltech sway bar. Remove the two frame bolts to detach the end link bracket from the frame. Remove the pivot bushing bracket bolts to detach the clamp. Detach the sway bar from the vehicle.






- 17. Thoroughly lubricate the inside of the supplied pivot bushings using the grease packet included with the kit.
- 18. Place the bushings on both sides of the Belltech sway bar, centered on the first set of bends. Once located, rotate the bushings slightly to evenly spread the lubricant. Place the bushing brackets over the bushings.



19. Ensure there is 1/32" to 1/16" of the bushing is showing after the bracket is seated. If the bushing is showing more than 1/16", use a sander or a sheet of coarse grit sandpaper to shave it down to the proper height.



20. Mount the sway bar and pivot bushing bracket on the original axle mount. Secure the sway bar assembly with the supplied 3/8"-16 x 1-1/4" bolts, washers, and Nyloc nuts. Hand tighten but do not torque yet. Ensure the sway bar is positioned below the axle.

#### **END LINK ASSEMBLY**



Stock height vehicles will use the 10" long bolts and 5-1/2" spacer tubes. Lowered height vehicles will use the 7" long bolts and 2-1/4" spacer tubes.

- 21. Use a floor jack to raise the rear axle until the jack stands are just beginning to unload, check for vehicle stability. Center the sway bar left to the right and front to rear.
- 22. Raise the ends of the sway bar until the arms are parallel with the frame rails. Mark the location on the bottom of the frame directly over the end link bolt hole. Alternatively, start from the oblong hole on the frame and measure back 9".






23. Lower the rear axle and check for vehicle stability. Drill through the bottom flange of the frame rail at the marked location with a 9/16" drill bit.

## Technician warning:


Before drilling, check for electrical, fuel, and brake system components on the inside of the frame rail being drilled. Relocate the components as necessary so they are not damaged during the frame modification.

#### **END LINK ASSEMBLY**


24. The end link assembly through the frame rails and the ends of the Belltech sway bar as shown in the diagram below.



25. Assemble the end links to the Belltech sway bar, as shown in the diagram.



- 26. Swing the sway bar up and position the ends of the arms as parallel as possible with the frame rails, under the drilled holes.
- 27. Mount the end link assembly to frame and tighten the end link bolt to the point where the spacer tube can still be forced to rotate on the bolt by hand, but the rubber grommets should not be able to rotate by hand.



28. Torque the U-bolts and pivot bushing clamps to 22 ft lbs.

# FINALIZING THE INSTALLATION

- 29. Mount the wheels and tighten the lug nuts
- 30. Lift the vehicle and remove the support stands.
- 31. Carefully lower the vehicle onto flat ground.
- 32. Torque the lug nuts to 125 ft lbs.
- 33. Check that all components and fasteners have been properly installed and torqued.
- 34. Read and perform all tasks in the "Before Driving Your Vehicle" section of page 1 of your instructions.
