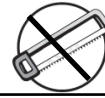

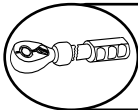

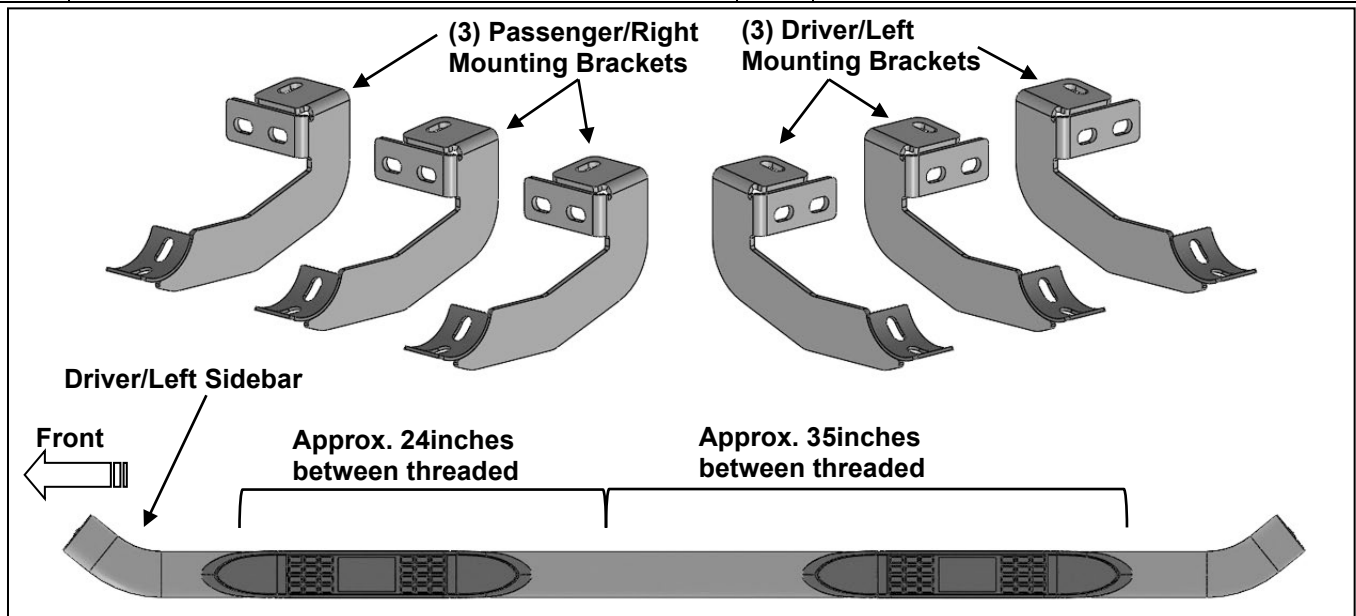

PROCEDURE:

1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.

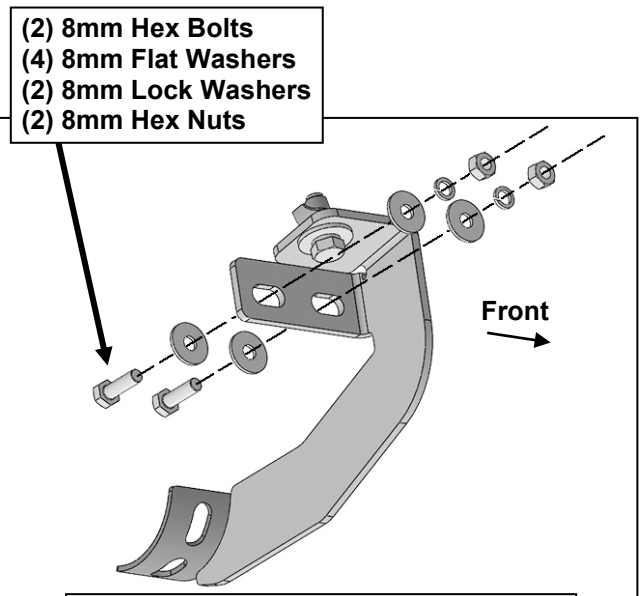
(Fig 1) Driver/Left front mounting location



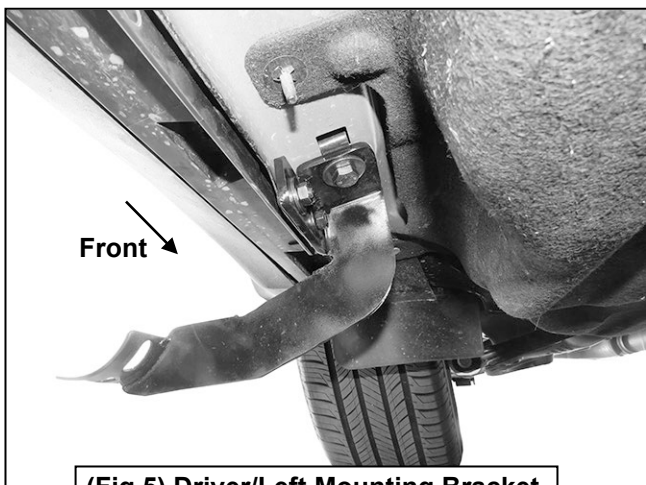
(Fig 2) Attach (1) 10mm Clip Nut into the Driver/Left front mounting location

2. Starting from under the front Driver/Left side, temporarily remove the plastic side panel. Move to the floor panel, locate the square holes and (2) round holes in the pinch weld, (Figure 1). Select (1) 10mm Clip Nut. Attach the Clip Nut into the square hole in the floor panel, (Figure 2).
3. Select (1) Driver/Left Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the 10mm Clip Nut with (1) 10mm Hex Bolt, (1) 10mm Lock Washer and (1) 10mm Flat Washer, (Figures 3 & 5). Do not tighten hardware.

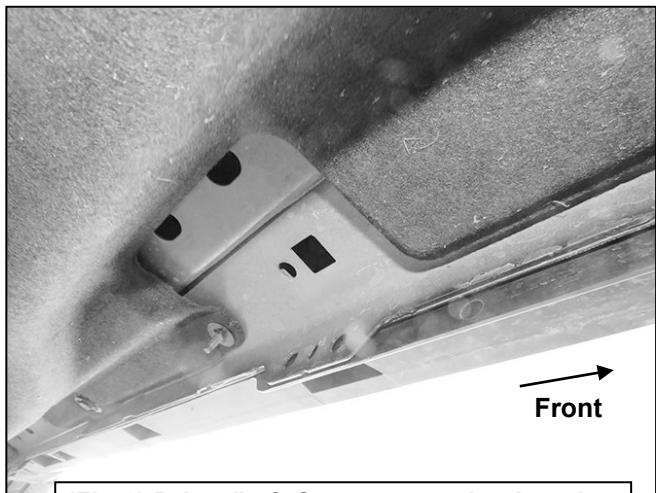


(Fig 4) Attach the Driver/Left Mounting Bracket to the pinch weld

4. Attach the Mounting Bracket to the pinch weld with (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (4) 8mm Flat Washers, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (Figure 4). Do not tighten hardware.
5. Move along the body to the center mounting location, (Figure 6). Repeat Steps 2—4 to attach the Mounting Bracket to the center location, (Figure 7). Do not tighten hardware.

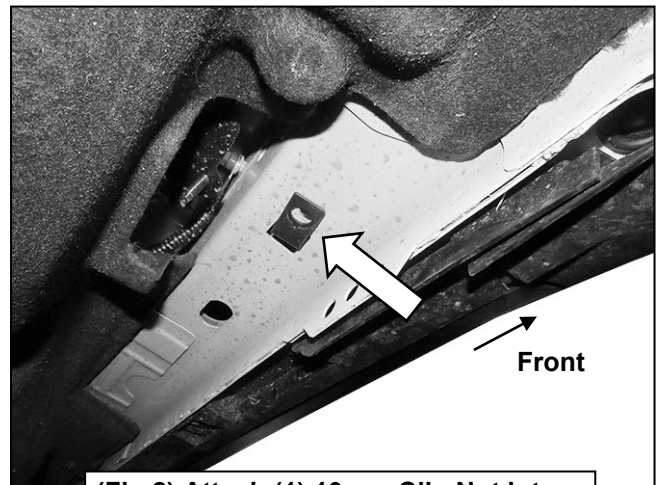
6. Move to the rear mounting location. Repeat **Steps 2—4** to attach the remaining (1) Driver/Left Mounting Bracket, (**Figures 8 & 9**). Do not tighten hardware.
7. Reattach the plastic side panel.
8. Unwrap the Driver/Left Sidebar. Carefully place Sidebar on the brackets. **IMPORTANT:** Do not slide or rotate Sidebar on cradles, or damage to the finish may result. Attach Sidebar to the Mounting Brackets with (6) 8mm Combo Bolts. Do not tighten hardware at this time, (**Figures 10—13**).
9. Level and adjust Sidebar and tighten all hardware.
10. Repeat **Steps 2—8** to attach the Passenger/Right Sidebar.
11. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Sidebar.

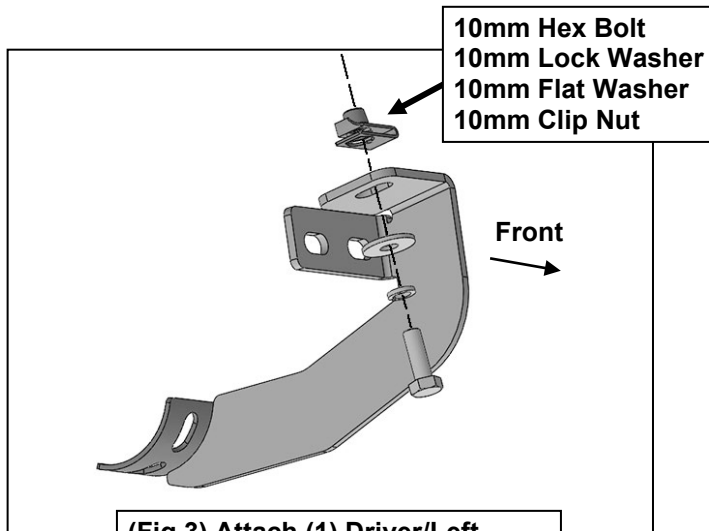

(Fig 3) Attach (1) Driver/Left Mounting Bracket to the Clip Nut

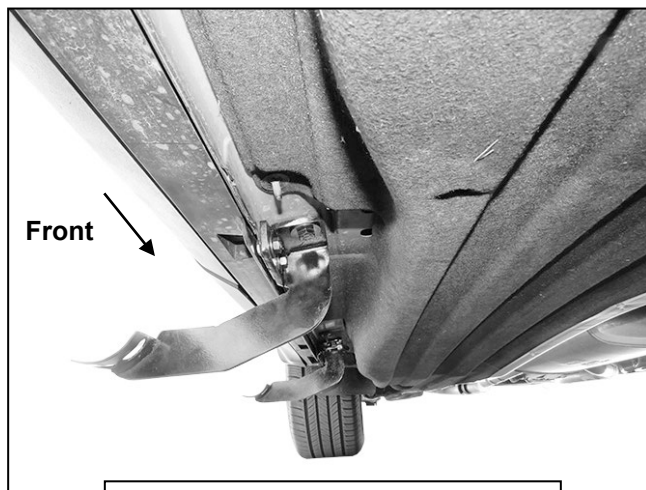


(Fig 5) Driver/Left Mounting Bracket attached to the front location

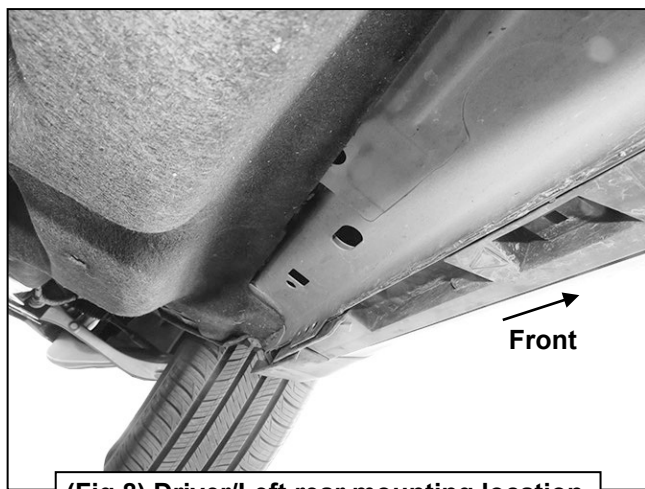

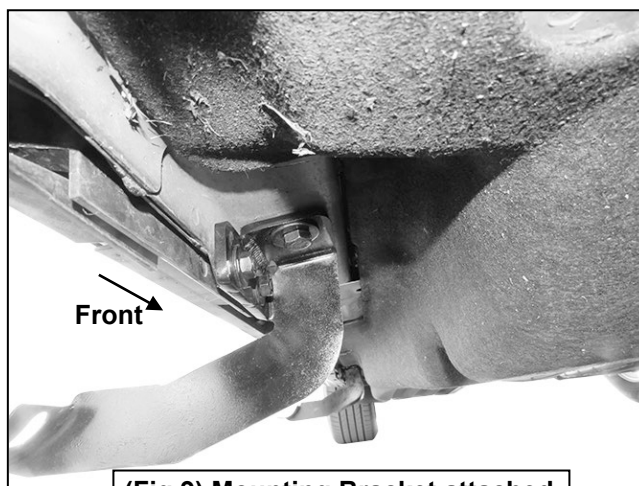
(Fig 6) Driver/Left Center mounting location



(Fig 7) Mounting Bracket attached to the Driver/Left center location

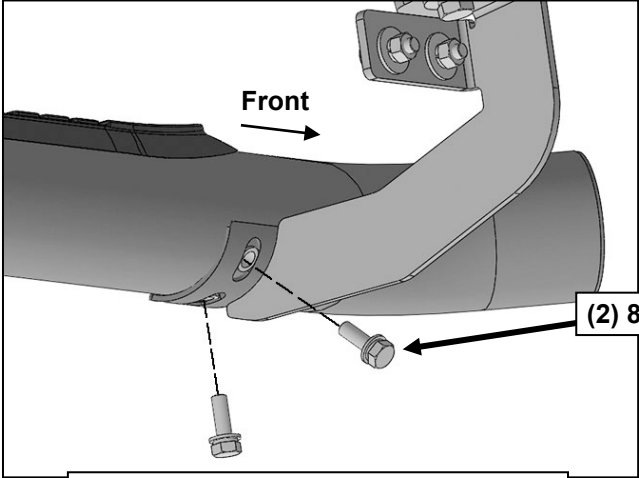


(Fig 8) Driver/Left rear mounting location

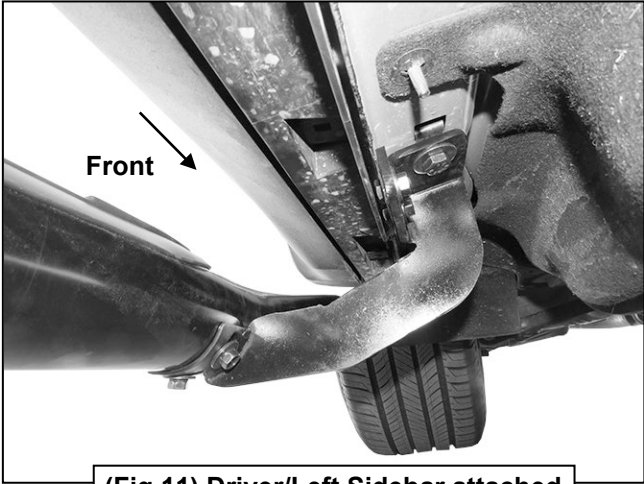


(Fig 9) Mounting Bracket attached to the Driver/Left rear location

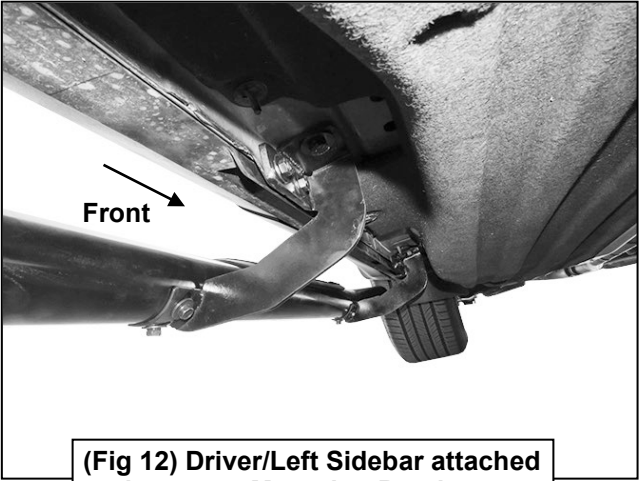

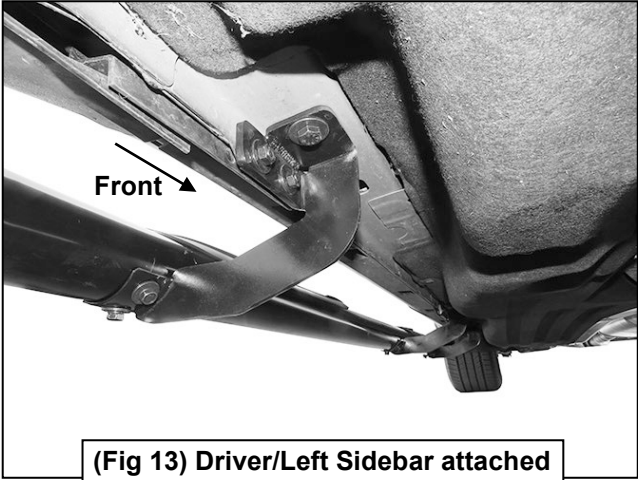
(Fig 10) Attach the Driver/Left Sidebar to the front Mounting Bracket

(Fig 12) Driver/Left Sidebar attached to the center Mounting Bracket

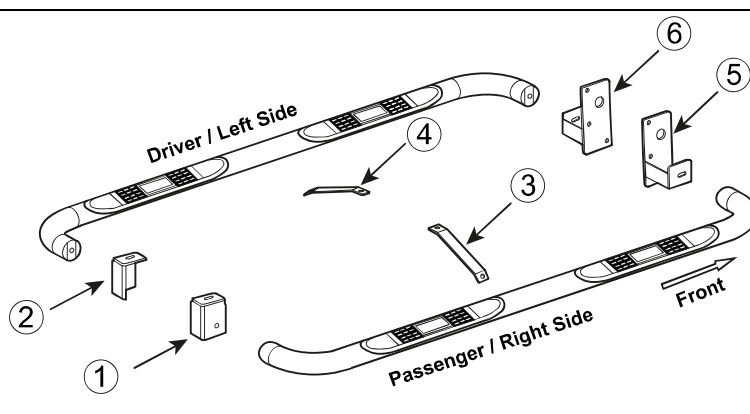


(Fig 13) Driver/Left Sidebar attached to the rear Mounting Bracket

- Product / Bracket image is representative and actual design may vary.

**PRODUCT CARE**

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- **Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax.** Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.
- Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs for **Stainless Steel finish.**
- Mild soap may be used to clean the product for both **Stainless Steel and Black finish.**

FAQ's**1. Hardware's are not of correct size.**

In GMC / Chevrolet truck model 2006 & up, customer needs to reuse the factory body bolts to install the bracket. If your vehicle is not GMC / Chevrolet 2006 & up, ensure that holes are not partially covered with any plastic grommet or rust? If it is, remove the plastic grommet & rust from the thread holes & re-try the installation.

2. Mounting Bracket are not getting Installed properly.

In some cases Illustration images shown in Installation manual may not be the exactly same as per actual vehicle images ,also if Driver / Passenger side mounting brackets are very identical in the design, suggest referring Parts Identification guide to avoid fitment issue.

3. Products are thumping / rattling after installation.

Ensure that all required mounting brackets / hardware's are installed & tighten correctly. Suggest using white lithium / regular grease between the metal to metal contact surfaces.

4. Side Bar is not aligning with vehicle / Step Pads are not aligning with vehicle doors.

Side bar may be interchanged or mounting brackets are not installed at the correct position in the vehicle. Refer Parts identification guide.

5. Missing / Excess Hardware.

Recheck hardware count as per the part list.

6. Product not installing properly.

Ensure make model year, cab length and bed size of your vehicle is listed in the application. All installation steps are followed correctly.
