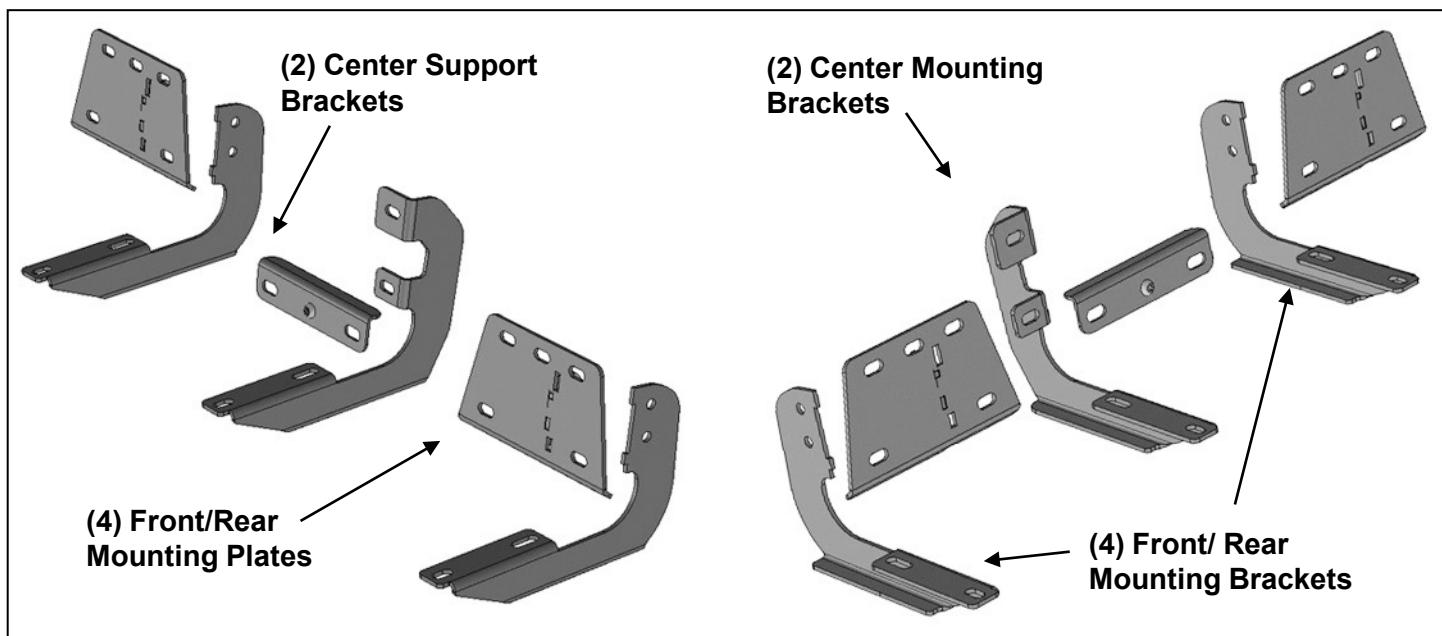

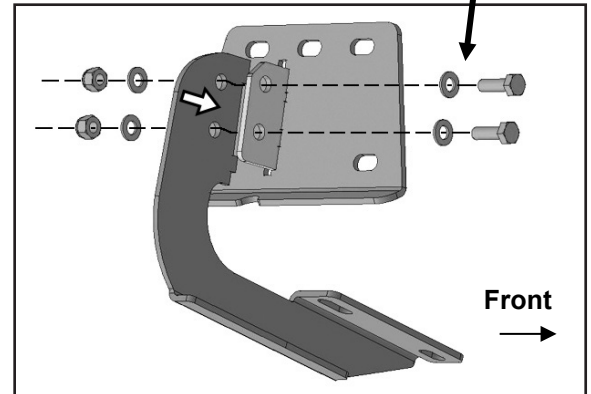
PROCEDURE

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. USE WIRE BRUSH TO CLEAN MOUNTING STUDS OF PAINT AND DEBRIS.

1. Start the installation under the driver/left side of the vehicle. Locate the (3) factory studs at the front mounting location closest to the front wheel opening, **(Figure 1)**.

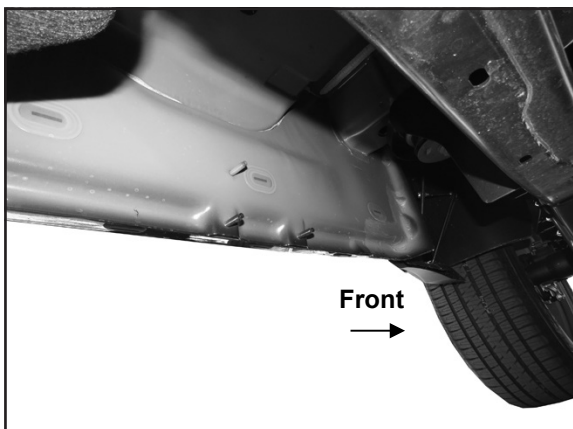


(Figure 2) Attach (1) front/rear Mounting Bracket to the back of (1) front/rear Mounting Plate.

2. Select (1) front/rear Mounting Plate and (1) front/rear Mounting Bracket, **(Figure 2)**. Attach the Mounting Bracket to the Mounting Plate with the included (2) 8mm x 25mm Hex Bolts, (4) 8mm x 16mm Small Flat Washers and (2) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 2)**. Push the Bracket into the Plate and tighten hardware.

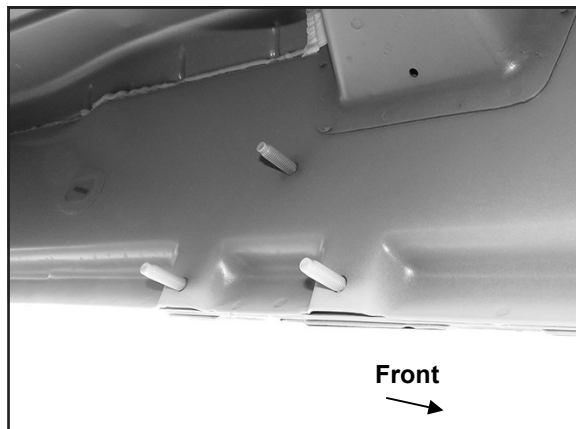


(Figure 4) Driver/left front Bracket assembly installed.

3. Attach the Mounting Bracket assembly to the (3) factory studs with (3) 8mm x 24mm STD Flat Washers and (3) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figures 3 & 4)**. Do not fully tighten hardware.

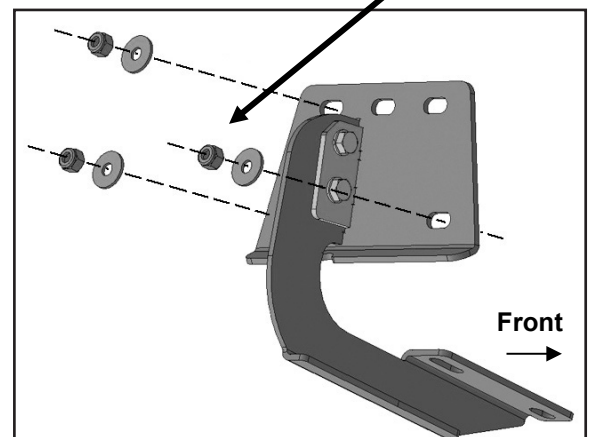

(2) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts

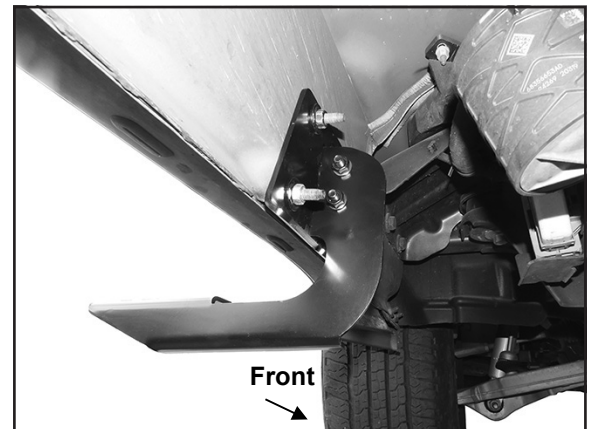
(3) 8mm x 24mm STD Flat Washers

(Figure 1) Driver/left front mounting location.

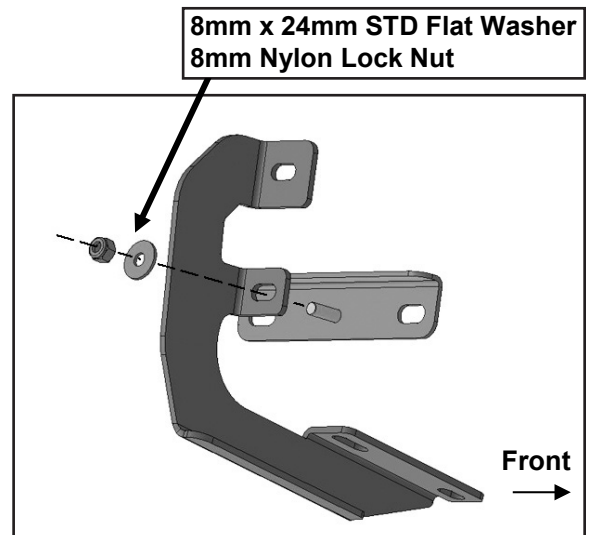
PROCEDURE (CONTINUED)

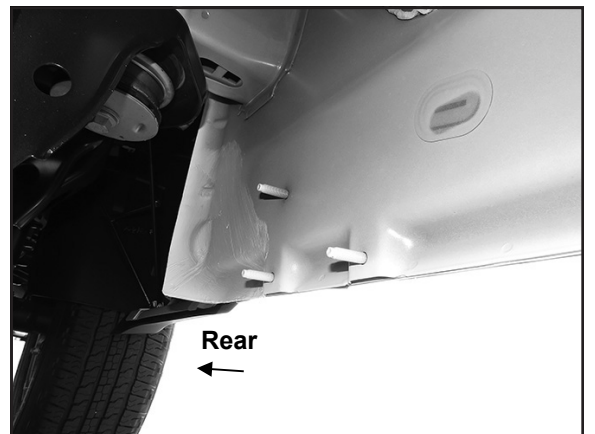
(Figure 5) Driver/left center mounting location.

4. Move along the body panel to the center mounting location, **(Figure 5)**. Repeat **Step 1** to clean the threaded studs.
5. Select (1) Center Support Bracket and (1) Center Mounting Bracket, **(Figure 6)**. Attach the Center Bracket to the mounting stud on the Support Bracket with the included (1) 8mm x 24mm STD Flat Washer and (1) 8mm Nylon Lock Nut, **(Figure 6)**. Fully tighten hardware.
6. Attach the Center Mounting Bracket assembly to the (3) factory studs with (3) 8mm x 24mm STD Flat Washers and (3) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 7)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
7. Continue along the side of the body to the last mounting location toward the end of the cab, **(Figure 8)**. Repeat **Steps 1-4** to assemble (1) front/rear Mounting Bracket and attach it to the rear mounting location along the body panel, **(Figures 2 & 3)**.
8. Carefully unwrap the Running Boards. Select **(Figure 4)**.

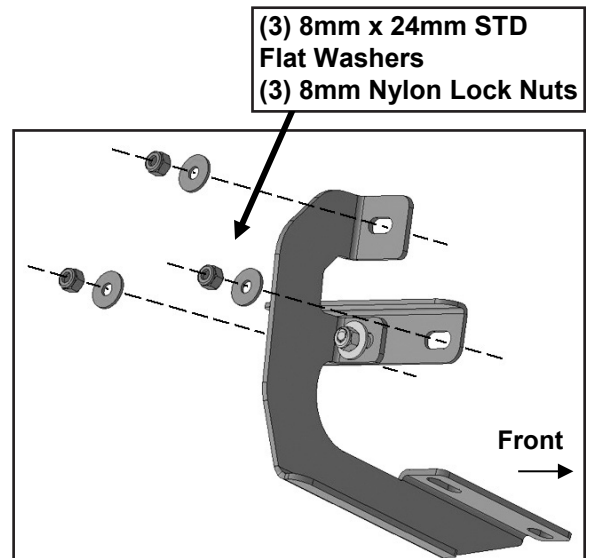
Driver/Left Side Installation Pictured

PROCEDURE (CONTINUED)

9. (1) Running Board. Insert (3) 8mm T-Bolts into each channel in the bottom of the Running Board, (**Figure 9**).

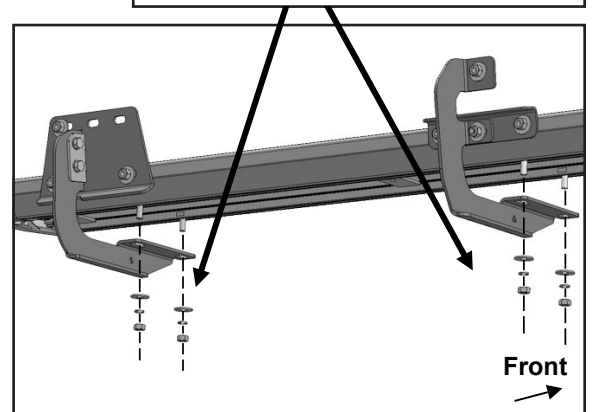


(Figure 10) Attach the driver/left Running Board to the front Mounting Bracket.

10. With assistance, place the Running Board on top of the Brackets. Guide the T-Bolts in the Running Board down through the slots in the Brackets, (**Figures 10 & 12**).

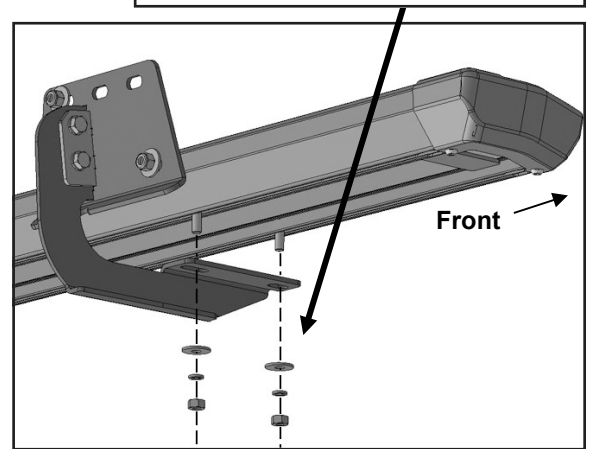
IMPORTANT: Do not slide, (front to back), the Running Board on the Brackets or damage to the finish may result.

11. Attach the Running Board to the Brackets with (6) 8mm x 24mm STD Flat Washers, (6) 8mm Lock Washers and (6) 8mm Hex Nuts, (**Figures 10-12**). Do not tighten hardware.

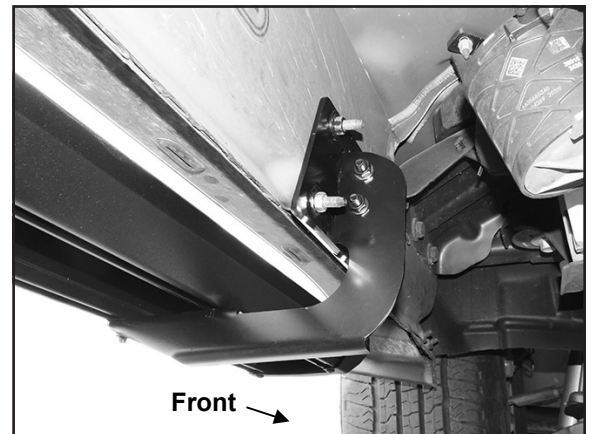
12. Level and adjust the Running Board to the vehicle and fully tighten all hardware.

(2) 8mm Hex Nuts

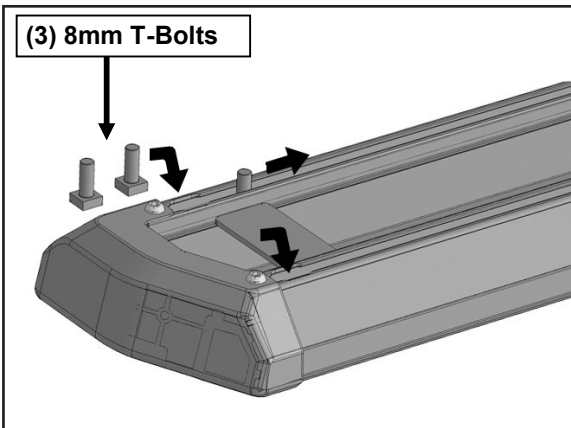
(Figure 11) Driver/left Running Board attached to the front Mounting Bracket.

(3) 8mm T-Bolts



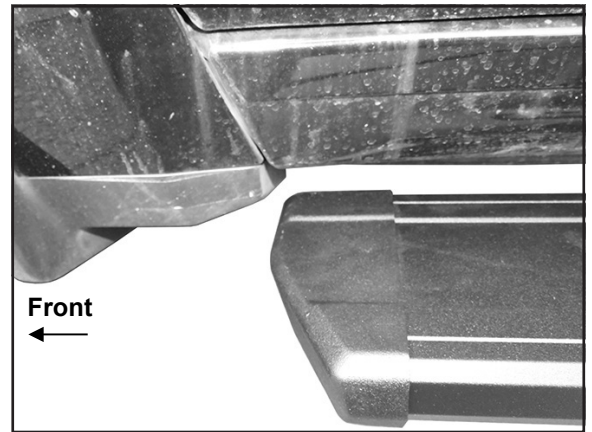
(Figure 9) Insert (3) 8mm T-Bolts into each channel in the bottom of the Running Board.

PROCEDURE (CONTINUED)

13. Repeat **Steps 1-12** to attach the passenger/right Running Board. **NOTE:** Measure the distance from the driver/left front wheel opening or front mud flap to the front end of the passenger/right running board, **(Figure 13)**. Apply this measurement to the passenger/right Running Board.

14. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

(Figure 13) Measure the distance from the front end of the driver/left Running Board to the front wheel opening or mud flap if equipped. Adjust passenger/right Running Board to match this measurement.

PRODUCT CARE

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax. Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.
- Mild soap may be used to clean the product for Black finish.

FAQs

Hardware and mounting brackets are not aligning properly.	Ensure that hardware is being used on the correct side of vehicle. In some cases, the hardware may appear the same for driver and passenger side but may alter the alignment of mounting location. Check mounting brackets for both sides.
Products are thumping / rattling after Installation.	Ensure that all required mounting brackets/hardware's are installed & tightened correctly. Suggest using white Lithium/regular grease between metal-to-metal contact.
Missing / Excess Hardware.	Recheck hardware count as per the part list.
Product not installing properly.	Ensure the Year/Make/Model as well as cab and bed dimensions are correct for the application. Review all steps for installation to ensure they were followed correctly.
