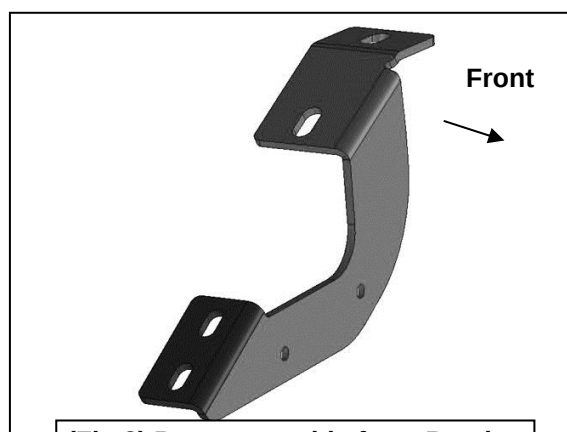
INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:**1. USE ILLUSTRATION TO PROPERLY IDENTIFY BRACKETS AND SIDEBARS.**

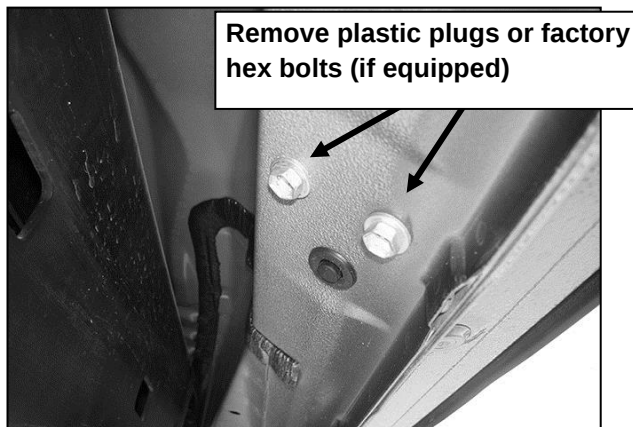


(Fig 3) Passenger front Bracket installation

2. Starting on the passenger side front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs or bolts covering the threaded holes in the body panel, (**Figure 1**). Select the passenger side front Mounting Bracket, (**Figure 2**). Attach the Bracket to the vehicle using the included (2) 8mm x 30mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (**Figure 3**). Do not tighten hardware at this time.

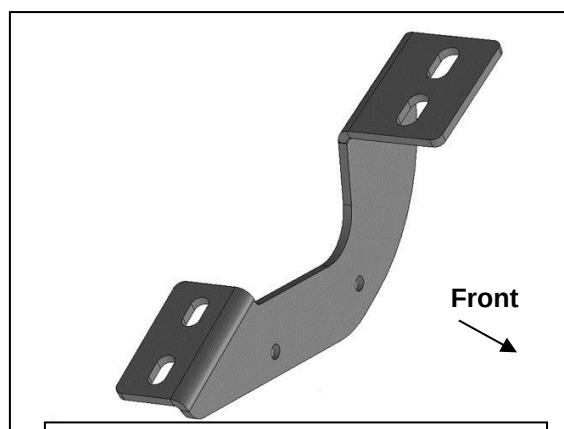
(Fig 4) Push center pin in to expand Clip in Bracket

3. Select (1) Plastic Bracket Cover and (2) Retaining Clips, (**Figure 4**). Slide the Cover over the front Bracket. Line up the mounting holes in the Cover with the holes in the Bracket. Insert (1) Clip into each hole and push center pin to expand Clip. Repeat this Step for all Cover installations.



(Fig 1) Passenger side front mounting location

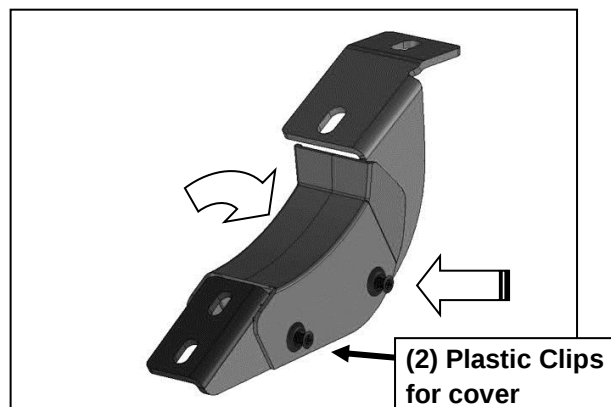

(Fig 2) Passenger side front Bracket

4. Move to the 2nd mounting location, (**Figure 5**). Repeat **Steps 2 & 3** for center Bracket installation, (**Figures 6—8**). **IMPORTANT:** There are (4) mounting locations along the side of the vehicle. Installation will use the 1st, 2nd and 4th mounting locations only.

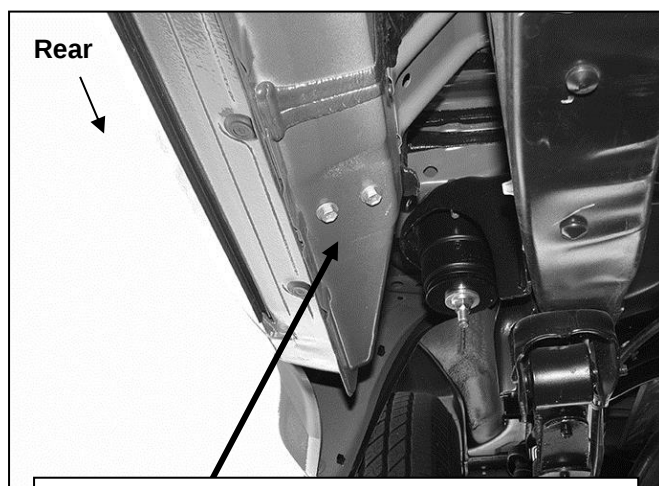


(Fig 7) Passenger side center Bracket installation

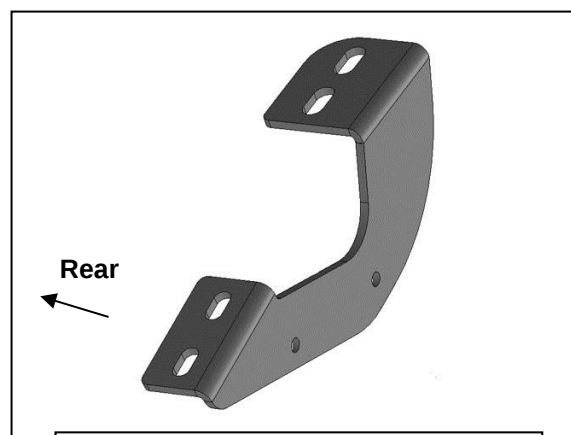


(Fig 8) Passenger side center Bracket with cover

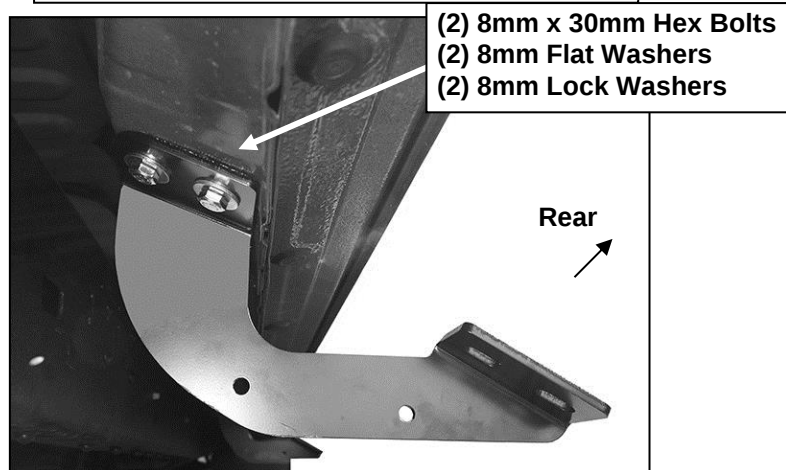
5. Continue along the body to the last mounting location at the rear of the cab, (Figure 9). Repeat **Steps 2 & 3** for rear Mounting Bracket installation, (Figures 9—11).



(Fig 9) Rear mounting location at back of cab

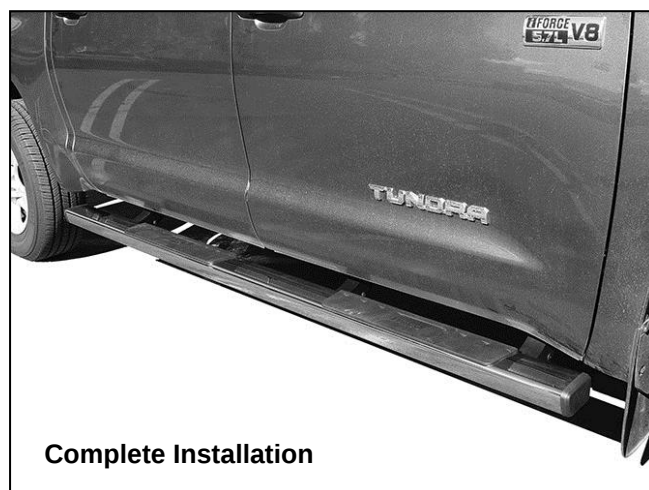
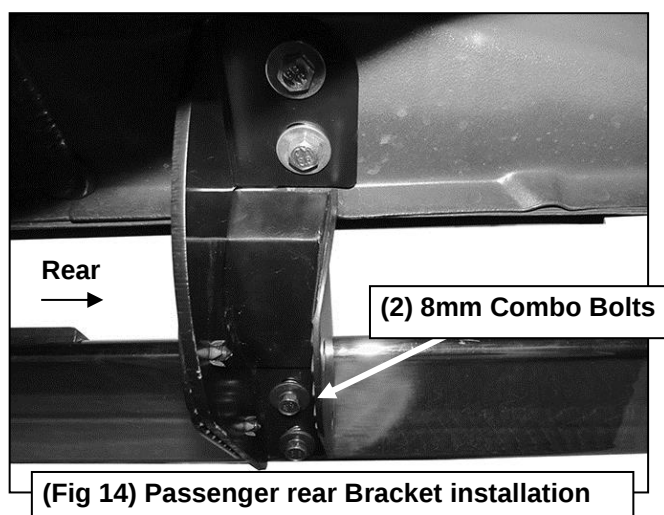
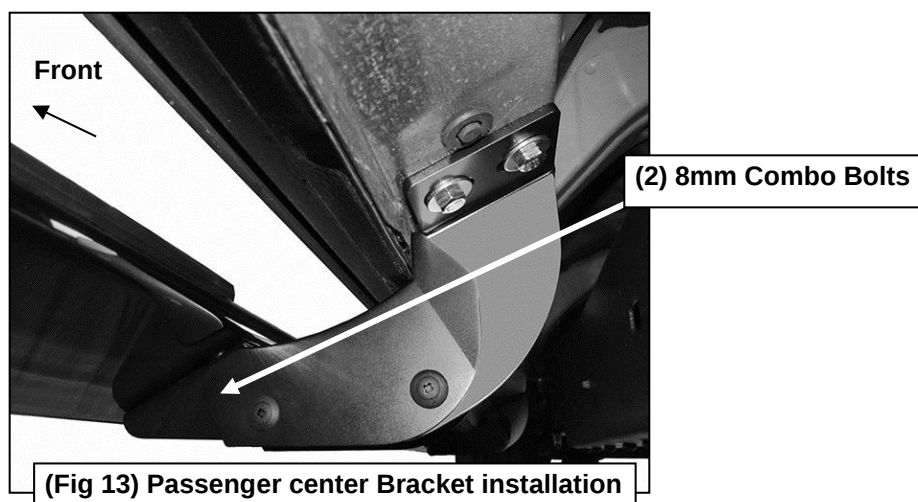
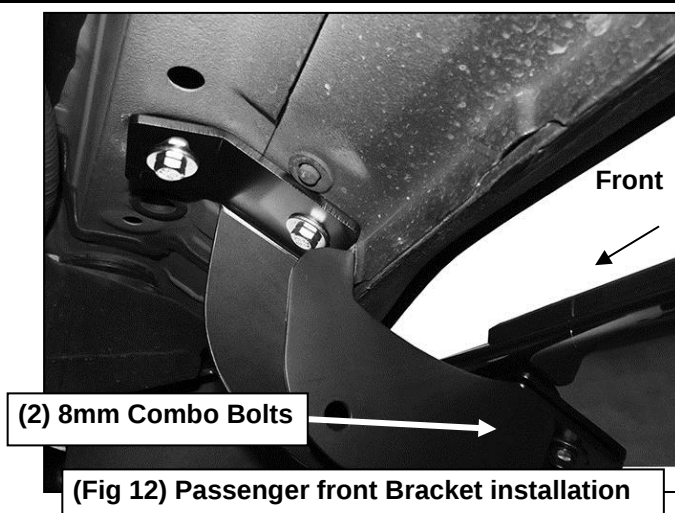


(Fig 10) Passenger side rear Bracket

6. Select the passenger/right Side Step. Carefully position the Side Step onto the (3) Mounting Brackets. **IMPORTANT:** Do not slide the Side Step on the Brackets or damage to the finish may result. Attach the Side Step to the Mounting Brackets with (6) 8mm x 25mm Combination Hex Bolts, (Figures 12—14). Do not tighten hardware.
7. Level and adjust the Side Step and fully tighten all hardware.
8. Repeat **Steps 2—7** for driver Side Step installation.
9. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.



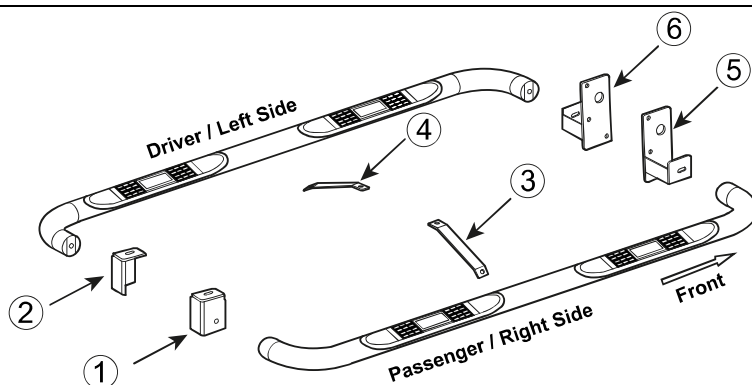
PARTS IDENTIFICATION GUIDE

Driver Side tube packed using "Green" color foam sheet. Passenger Side tube packed using "White" color foam sheet

No.	Parts Identification
1	Passenger / Right 'Rear' Bracket marked "PR"
2	Driver / Left 'Rear' Bracket marked "DR"
3	Passenger / Right 'Center' Bracket marked "PC"
4	Driver / Left 'Center' Bracket marked "DC"
5	Passenger / Right 'Front' Bracket marked "PF"
6	Driver / Left 'Front' Bracket marked "DF"

Note:

- This guide is to identify the parts and not a reference for part count.
- For part count, refer Parts List.
- Product / Bracket image is representative and actual design may vary.

**PRODUCT CARE**

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- **Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax.** Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.
- Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs for **Stainless Steel finish.**
- Mild soap may be used to clean the product for both **Stainless Steel and Black finish.**

FAQ's**1. Hardware's are not of correct size.**

In GMC / Chevrolet truck model 2006 & up, customer needs to reuse the factory body bolts to install the bracket. If your vehicle is not GMC / Chevrolet 2006 & up, ensure that holes are not partially covered with any plastic grommet or rust? If it is, remove the plastic grommet & rust from the thread holes & re-try the installation.

2. Mounting Bracket are not getting Installed properly.

In some cases Illustration images shown in Installation manual may not be the exactly same as per actual vehicle images ,also if Driver / Passenger side mounting brackets are very identical in the design, suggest referring Parts Identification guide to avoid fitment issue.

3. Products are thumping / rattling after installation.

Ensure that all required mounting brackets / hardware's are installed & tighten correctly. Suggest using white lithium / regular grease between the metal to metal contact surfaces.

4. Side Bar is not aligning with vehicle / Step Pads are not aligning with vehicle doors.

Side bar may be interchanged or mounting brackets are not installed at the correct position in the vehicle. Refer Parts identification guide.

5. Missing / Excess Hardware.

Recheck hardware count as per the part list.

6. Product not installing properly.

Ensure make model year, cab length and bed size of your vehicle is listed in the application. All installation steps are followed correctly.

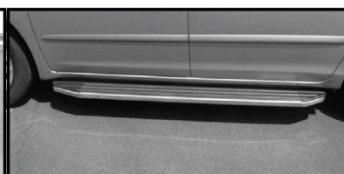
