Removal of Stock System

1. Apply penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.

2. Disconnect wiring harness from both exhaust valve actuators. Refer to Figure 1.

3. Loosen band clamp at the inlet of the OEM catback. **Refer to Figure 2.**

4. Remove the front and mid hangers from their rubber isolators.

5. Unbolt both rear muffler hangers from the vehicle and remove the complete catback exhaust from the vehicle. Remove the OEM bandclamp and both rear muffler hangers from the OEM exhaust as these will be reused during the

installation of your **MBRP** performance exhaust. **Refer to Figure 3.**

Installation of MBRP Performance Exhaust

1. Using the factory band clamp, install the **Front Pipe**. Do not fully tighten until all parts are installed. Install the hanger into the rubber isolator. **Refer to Figure 4.**

Pre-install the OEM muffler hanger assemblies onto both MBRP muffler assemblies.
Refer to Figure 5.

3. Using a supplied **3**" **Clamp**, install the **Y-Pipe Assembly** onto the **Front Pipe.** Install the hanger into the factory rubber isolator. **Refer to Figure 6.**

4. Using a **3**" **Clamp**, install the **Passenger-Side Muffler Assembly** onto the **Y-Pipe Assembly**. Lift the **Passenger-Side Muffler Assembly** up and secure the OEM hanger assembly to the vehicle with the previously removed bolt. NOTE; The OEM hanger assemblies have slotted mounting holes that can be used to center the tips in the rear facia when the installation is complete. **Refer to Figures 7 and 8.**

5. Repeat Step 4 for the Driver-Side Muffler Assembly.

6. Install the **Tips** and align to your preference. **Refer to Figure 9.**

7. Plug the two Valve Simulators into the wiring harness and secure the wiring out of the way with cable ties. Refer to Figure 10.

8. Align the edge of band clamp with the edge of the joint it is connecting. Tighten all hardware and clamps, starting at the front and working rearward to secure the system. Check along the full length of the exhaust system to ensure there is adequate clearance for fuel lines, vent lines, brake lines, frame, bodywork, suspension, and any wiring, etc. If there is any interference detected, relocate, or adjust to provide adequate clearance. Ensure all clamp connections are secure and components are unable to rotate or slide. Band clamps require approximately 45 lb-ft (60 N-m) of torque. Verify clearances, system security and band clamp torque after 30- 60 miles (50-100 km) of driving.
