

MBRP Header Installation Instructions 2009-2015 Rev XR/MX



Note: Local regulations may limit or prohibit modification to your snowmobile's emissions system and/or the sound levels that it generates. It is your responsibility to be aware of restrictions that may apply to your intended use of this product.

- 1. Remove the springs fastening the stock muffler to the frame and the exhaust pipe. (Set springs safely aside so they can be reused)
- 2. Remove the stock muffler.
- 3. Remove the stock mid pipe and header pipe from the machine. Re-install the stock muffler in its original location.
- 4. Install the stock header gasket back onto the studs if it has come off, and loosely install the mid pipe of the MBRP header assembly.
- 5. Install the MBRP header assembly, ensuring that the clamp is on the middle pipe.
- 6. Align the stock muffler inlet with the MBRP header pipe outlet, and fasten using the stock springs.
- 7. Remove the stock hanger bracket from the front of the sled. Install the hanger bracket onto the hanger of the MBRP header pipe, and then fasten the hanger to the sled using the stock stud that aligns with the hanger bracket brace.
- 8. Install the heat tape on the bottom side of the air box for added heat protection

NOTE: To avoid exhaust leaks use high heat silicone to seal all connections between expansion chambers and muffler. Monitor for leaks during the first 200 miles after your installation and re-apply silicone where necessary. We suggest having your local snowmobile mechanic or performance shop install this product.

CAUTION: **<u>DO NOT</u>** touch muffler while snowmobile is running or shortly after it has run, as it may result in personal injury.
