SILVER SPORT

SPEEDOMETER CABLE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

FOR ALL SILVER SPORT AUTOMATIC OR MANUAL TRANSMISSIONS WITH A MECHANICAL SPEEDOMETER CABLE

- 1. Remove the drive cable from the speedometer cable housing by pulling it out of the speedometer end of the housing.
- 2. Lubricate the drive cable moderately with speedometer cable grease (provided).
- 3. Reinsert the drive cable into the housing from the speedometer end.

4. Lightly lubricate the large O-ring with the correct type of transmission fluid for your particular transmission.

- 5. Install the large O-ring over the end of the cable so that it is completely seated in the wide groove on the body of the speedometer cable.
- 6. IMPORTANT!!! Pack the transmission end of the speedometer cable housing heavily with wheel bearing grease. Install the small O-ring on the transmission end of the drive cable. It will be a very loose fit.



- 7. Install the speedometer gear over the same end of the cable so that the drive cable fits into the square hole inside the plastic gear.
- 8. Insert the retaining clip into the slots on the back side of the speedometer gear with the lip on the clip pointing away from the transmission. It will be a snug fit and you may have to push lightly on the speedometer gear in order to compress the small O-ring.
- 9. Rotate the speedometer gear. There should be a small amount of drag. If the gear is difficult to turn: remove retaining clip and gear, ensure that the small O-ring is not pinched, and then reassemble.
- 10. Attach the opposite end of the cable to your speedometer.
- 11. Remove the rubber or plastic plug from the speedometer output port on the left side of your transmission.
- 12. Insert the gear end of the speedometer cable into the transmission. Install the retaining bolt and lock washer, torque to 5 ft/lbs.
- 13. Continue with your transmission installation.
