

# Ford Ranger 2019-2023 INSTALLATION SHEET Any damaged or missing parts?

#### NOTE: Please read all instructions before assembling the bed cover.

Keep the boxes and packaging until the installation is complete. Unpack carefully to prevent scratching. DO NOT remove any protective films from the cover and canister until after the installation is complete. DO NOT USE A LUBRICANT OR THREAD-LOCKER ADHESIVE ON THE ROLLING COVER. USE OF THESE WILL VOID THE WARRANTY. See the maintenance page for proper care.




# Install bulkhead foam seal: Clean the top of the bulkhead with soap and water to remove dirt and debris. Clean the area with isopropyl alcohol to remove wax or grease and to evaporate any remaining water. Allow the surface to dry. Peel off the paper adhesive backing and apply the foam seal (T) to the top of the bulkhead. The seal should be oriented as shown, flush with the inside face and snug between the bed rail caps. Install the foam block seals: Clean the top of the bulkhead underneath the bed rail cap with isopropyl alcohol to remove wax or grease and to evaporate any remaining water. Allow the surface to dry. Peel off the paper adhesive cover and apply the foam block seal (V) to the top of the bulkhead and underneath the bed rail cap. Install one foam block on each side. Apply pressure evenly to the entire seal to ensure proper adhesion. Plug the bulkhead face holes: Plug the small holes in the corner of the bulkhead face.

**4** Routing wire harness from battery to truck bed: Using a wire tie (E), secure the fuse holder (B) end of the wire harness (D) near the battery (red wire and brown wire). Note: Do not connect the wiring harness (D) to your battery yet.

5 Route the wire harness (D) to the driver side of the truck if it is not already. Note: Using wire ties (E), secure the wiring harness (D) so it does not come into contact with moving parts or exhaust pipes.

6 Route the wiring harness (D) down along the frame rails to the truck box as shown on the right. Keep the wires as high as possible to prevent damage while driving. Secure the wiring harness (D) with ties (E) every 2-3 feet.


#### Option 1:


Route the wiring (D) to the driver side drain hole in the truck bed (leave about 24" in truck bed). Use split wire loom (A) to wrap around the wires as a barrier between the wires and the drain tube hole.

Note: This may require a larger hole than normal.

#### Option 2:

Route the wiring (D) in the gap between the cab and truck bed leaving about 24" in the truck bed. The wires will be hidden under the front weather stripping of the Retrax cover.







# XR Rail system clamp installation: 17a - The adjustable-back clamp is designed and tested for the extra loads for the retractable cover with the XR rail system. The adjustable-back clamps must be positioned correctly under the truck bed rail to properly carry the extra loads. 17c - If the jaw does not contact firmly into the corner of the bed flange, remove the clamp and loosen the screws to adjust the 17b - The adjustable top jaw jaw. of the clamp must be tucked firmly to the top and inside corner of the sheet Re-tighten screws and metal of the truck bed rail. fully engage the lock washers. Alwavs make sure the two sets of teeth are fully engaged. 17d - Replace the clamp between the adjustment screws and recheck to make sure the jaw seats firmly into the corner of the truck bed rail. Position the clamps between the adjustment screws both front and back. Using a 9/16" wrench, tighten the clamps. It is important to push down on the rail while tightening. AND to tilt the rail up approximately two degrees simultaneously. Both the pushing down and tilting of the rail will position the rail best to minimize water intrusion. Tighten the clamp bolts to: 6.7 ft-lbf 9,1 N-m 17e. Tighten the rail clamp stand-off bolt: From steps 17, 18 & 19 the rails are now adjusted to be even. Loosen the jam nut, then tighten the stand-off bolt until the bumper firmly contacts the truck bed wall. Re-tighten $\odot$ the iam nut. Jam Nut Do Not over torque the bolt. Tighten the jam nuts to: 6.7 ft-lbf NOTE: If the clamps need to be 9,1 N-m removed after the stand-off bolts are set, the jam nut and bolt will


have to be loosened.







With the cover closed and latched, if there is less weatherstrip exposed on one side versus the other then adjust that rail more forward and toward the cab. Loosen the clamps and move the rail. Check again for equal spacing, adjust as necessary then tighten all the clamps per step 16.



# Remove the protective film and install the drain tubes: 21a. Remove all of the protective plastic film from the canister (M). 21b. Insert the drain tube (Q) into the canister (M) on both sides, rotate to the right, clockwise, the fitting will click twice when secure. 21c. Generally the drain tubes (Q) will be routed out through a hole drilled in the factory bed plug. Otherwise a suitable existing hole must be utilized. Or a new hole can be drilled, taking great caution to be aware of lines and anything behind where the hole is drilled. NOTE: For better water drainage, be sure to route the drain hose out of the truck in the most direct line as possible.



For proper cover operation, ensure rails are positioned correctly (must be parallel). See steps 18 & 19.






#### **FINAL NOTES**

- Open and close the cover to ensure that it is rolling without rubbing or binding.
- Open and close the tailgate to check for proper movement.
- On some models, a better fit with the tailgate may be obtained if the rear of the rails are adjusted slightly up or down.
- · Remove all remaining protective film.
- Recheck that all of the clamps are tight.
- Do this periodically throughout the use of the cover.
- Check that the rails are level and spaced evenly, and adjust accordingly.










To prevent damage or loss of cargo when driving, check to make sure cross bars and cargo are securely fastened. Loading cargo on the roof rack will make the vehicle's center of gravity higher. Avoid high speeds, sudden starts, sharp turns, sudden braking or abrupt maneuvers; otherwise, it may result in a loss of control. If driving for a long distance on rough roads, or at high speeds, occasionally stop the vehicle and make sure the cargo remains in its place. Do not ever exceed the maximum vehicle capacity when loading the vehicle.



#### USE

#### Opening and using the cover

To use your cover, open the lock cover and press the button at the center of the latch to pop open the handle.

#### Closing and locking the cover

To latch your cover anywhere along the rail, push down firmly on the end of the lock handle. Insert the key and turn until it is locked or unlocked.

#### Lock cover adjustment

A 3/32" Allen wrench can be used to adjust the pointed set-screw on the lock arm. Turn clockwise to increase latching pressure on the rail, or turn counter-clockwise if the lock is too hard to close.

#### Securing loose cargo

Retractable covers help in transporting loose and large cargo, a unique feature that most bed covers cannot claim. NOTE: Cargo should still be secured to the truck bed to prevent it from coming loose.

To help secure any item too big to fit under the cover, latch the lock handle shut against the item to help keep it in place.

#### **MAINTENANCE & CARE**

#### Cleaning and caring for your cover.


You can wash the cover, but do not use any cleaners, protectants or strong chemicals. The cover should be cleaned with mild soap and water.


Do not allow gasoline to come in contact with the cover.

The weather stripping may absorb soapy residue from a car wash, it is recommended to wipe down the inside of the rails from time to time.

#### IMPORTANT: NEVER spray any lubricant or cleaner in the rails. THIS WILL VOID THE WARRANTY.

The bearings are sealed and will not need any lubricant or spray. If the rails feel sticky, run paraffin wax along the rail.





# **COVER CARE AND MAINTENANCE**

Clean with mild automotive soap and water only. Do NOT use any strong chemicals or cleaners. Do not allow gasoline to come in contact with the cover.

DO NOT wax your Retrax cover. The weather-stripping on your cover may absorb soapy residue from a car wash, so we recommend wiping down the inside of your rails from time to time.

**IMPORTANT:** NEVER spray any lubricant or cleaner on the rails. THIS WILL VOID YOUR WARRANTY. The ball bearings are sealed and will not need any lubricant or spray. If the rails feel a little 'sticky', you may rub some Paraffin (candle) wax along them until they wear in.

It is recommended that you periodically check that the cover is securely attached to your truck bed. Inspect the clamps and front mounting bolts to ensure they were properly installed and have not come loose or knocked out of adjustment during operation. Covers that are used with high frequency or that are subject to the vibrations and impact from rough roadways can cause the cover to require adjustment.

# USE

#### **OPENING AND USING THE COVER**

To use your RETRAX cover, open the lock cover and press the button at the center of the latch to pop open the handle.

#### **CLOSING AND LOCKING THE COVER**


To latch your RETRAX cover anywhere along the rail, push down firmly on the end of the lock handle using both thumbs. Insert the key and make sure it locks and unlocks.

#### SECURING LOOSE CARGO

RETRAX covers help transport loose and large pieces of cargo safely and securely; a unique feature that most tonneau covers cannot claim. To help secure any item too big to fit under the cover, latch the lock handle shut against the item to keep it in place.

# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- DO NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.
- DO NOT allow gasoline to come in contact with the cover.
- · All large and heavy cargo must be secured by straps.
- NEVER allow children or pets to occupy the truck bed while the cover is closed.
- · The cover is not airtight. Special care is required to keep cargo clean and dry.
- Tonneau covers won't prevent theft of contents inside the truck box.



# LIMITED WARRANTY

# WARRANTY COVERAGE

This truck bed cover is warrantied against defects in materials or workmanship as follows. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

**Powertrax** - The truck bed covers carries a limited warranty for three (3) years from the original date of purchase, subject to the terms below.

# WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE

The warranty is to the initial consumer purchasing the truck bed cover and it is not transferable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce these warranty rights.

# WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Failure to follow these care and use instructions will void the warranty:

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only. Do not use any strong chemicals or cleaners. Lubrication of the rails or sealed ball bearings will void the warranty.
- Cargo must be secured at all points when the vehicle is in motion. Failure to adequately secure the cover or tether strap can result in damage and will void the warranty.
- Check all clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, the cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- DO NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

### WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective truck bed cover or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranty, to substitute a newer model or bed cover having a similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

# WARRANTY RETURN

A Return Material Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As a consumer, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.
