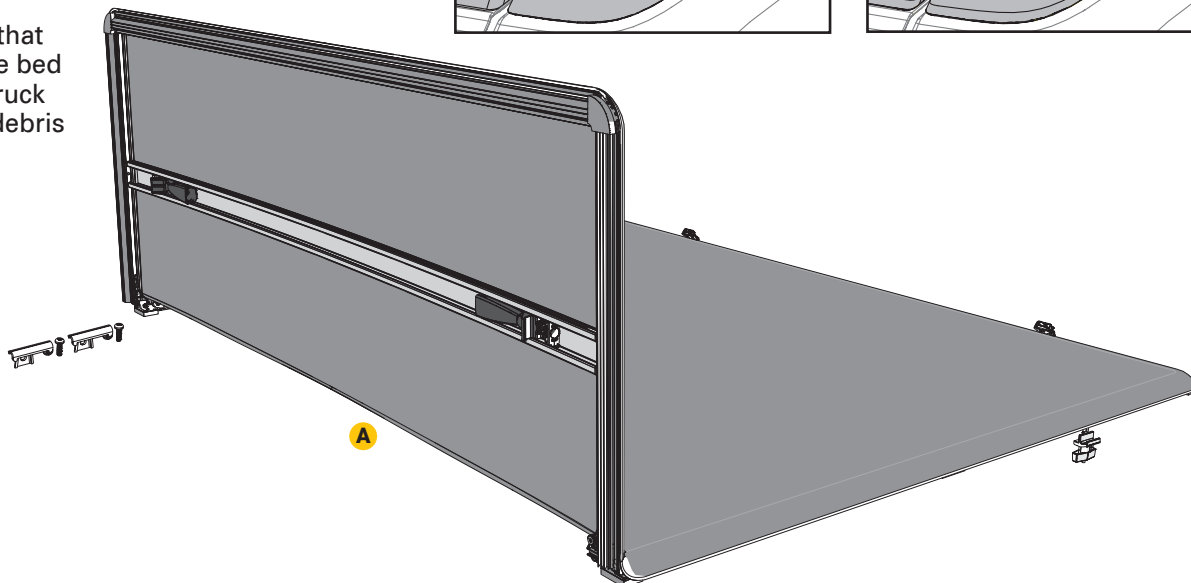


Prior to installation, it is important to examine the bed rails of your vehicle to accurately determine which model year you have. For our purposes, if your bed rail stake pocket covers look like picture A, we refer to your truck as the 2024 model year. If they look like picture B, we refer to your truck as the 2025 model year.

NOTE: It is important that all the areas where the bed cover mounts to the truck are clean and free of debris before installation.



TOOLS REQUIRED

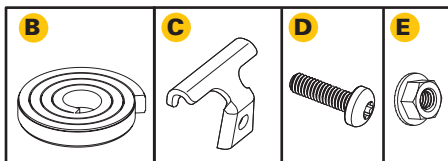
- Utility knife

- T-30 Torx bit

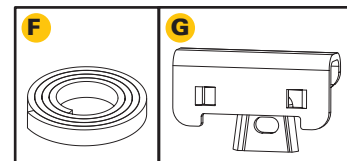
- B** 1x Bulkhead seal

- E** 4x M6 Nuts



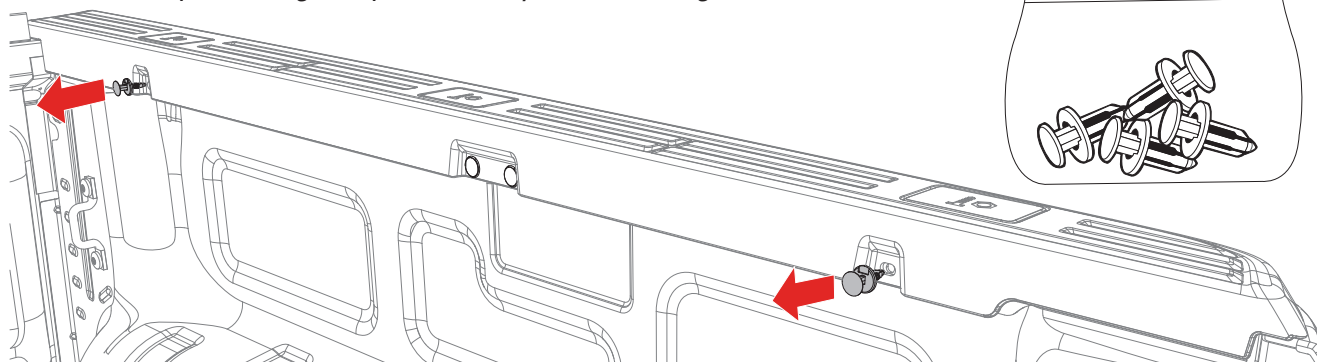

- G** 4x Clamp brackets

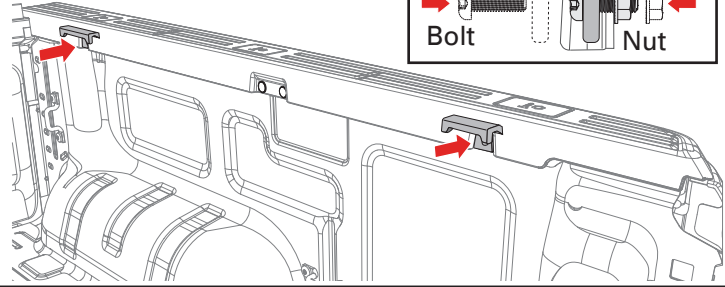
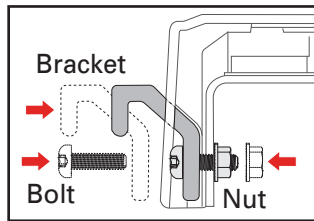


- 1** Remove the two corner clips from the passenger and driver side bed caps. Store them in a plastic bag and put them in your vehicle's glove box.



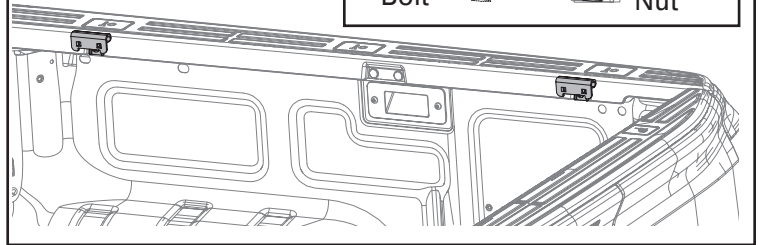
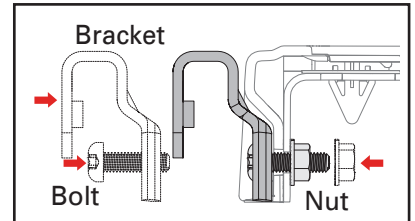
2A **FOR 2024:** Install the brackets (C), bolts (D) and nuts (E) provided using the T-30 tool on the passenger and driver side bed caps, where you removed the two corner clips in Step 1. Make sure the nut is behind the sheet metal, as shown below.

NOTE: Torque to 8 ft/lbs (11 Nm).



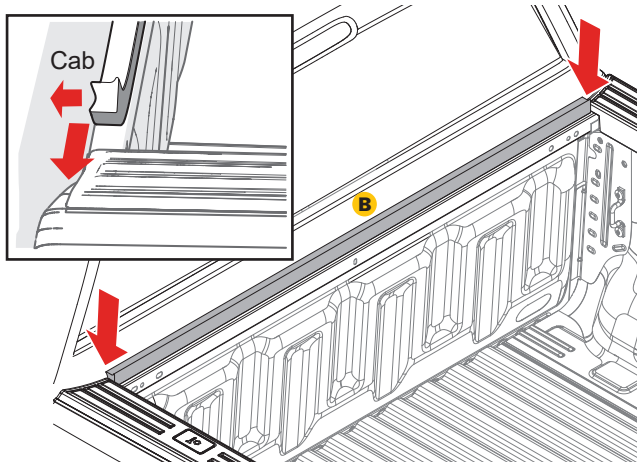
2B **FOR 2025:** Install the brackets (G), bolts (D) and nuts (E) provided using the T-30 tool on the passenger and driver side bed caps, where you removed the two corner clips in Step 1. Make sure the nut is behind the sheet metal, as shown below.

NOTE: Torque to 8 ft/lbs (11 Nm).

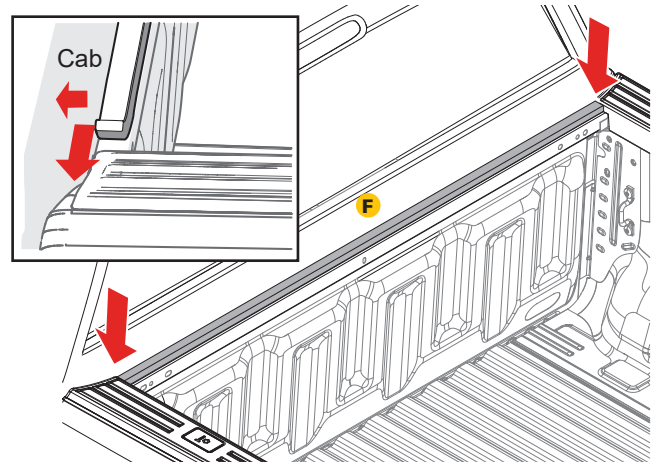


3 Install the bulkhead seal. Clean the top of the bulkhead where the seal will go with soap and water to remove dirt and debris. Then clean the same area with isopropyl alcohol to remove wax or grease and to evaporate any remaining water. Allow the surface to dry. The seal should be placed flush with the front edge of the bulkhead and should be snug between the truck bed rails. Peel the backing paper from the bulkhead seal (B) for **2024 models** and bulkhead seal (F) for **2025 models** and apply pressure to the entire seal to make sure that the adhesion is good.

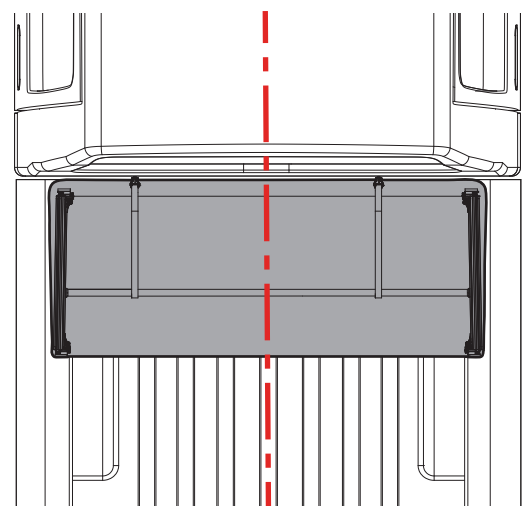
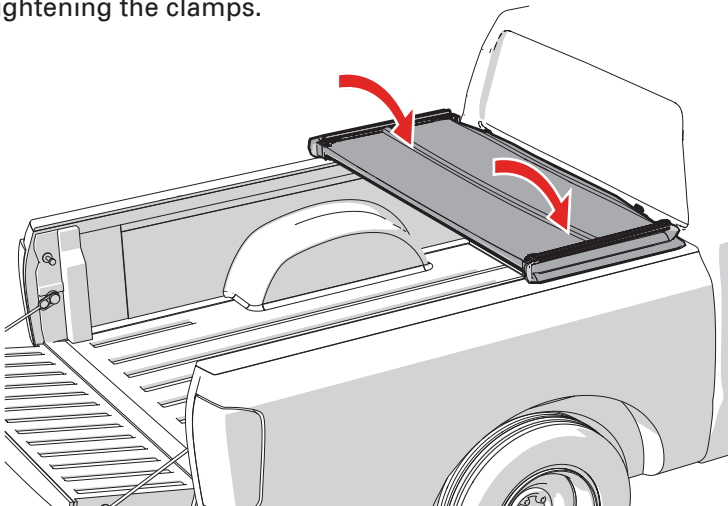

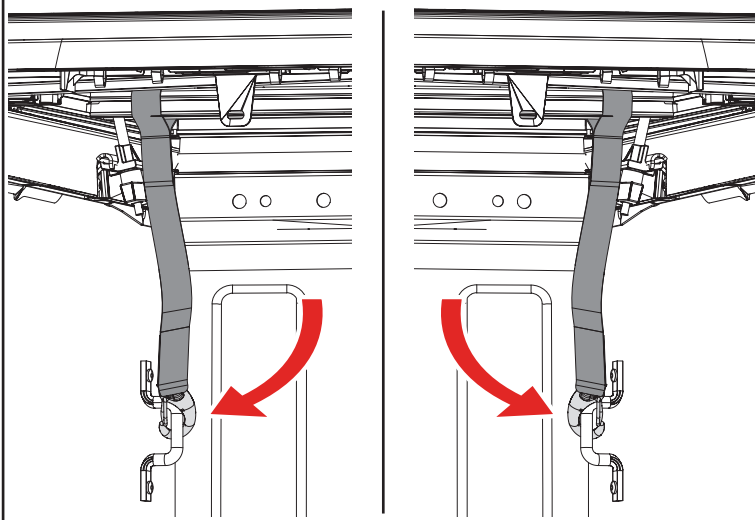
4 **INSTALLING COVER.** **Note:** Take care not to damage or deform the seals when installing the bed cover onto the truck bed. Visually check to ensure the front bed cover frame is even on both sides and square with the bed. Place the bed cover over the cab end and of the truck bed. Make sure the cover is centered on the bed of the vehicle before tightening the clamps.



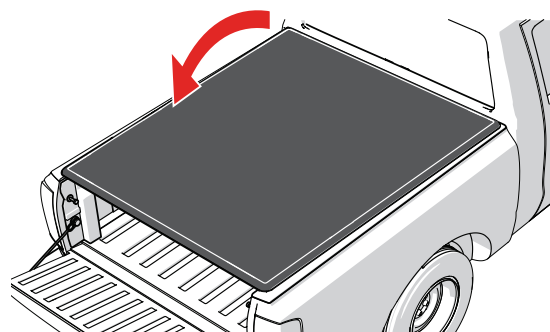
- 5** Ensure that the clamp is positioned under the previously installed bracket. Hand tighten until clamp contacts the bracket, then tighten an additional two turns. **DO NOT** secure to only the lip of the bedliner or the plastic bed cap. **DO NOT** use a wrench or overtighten!



- 6** Attach the tether to the front tie-down on both the driver and passenger side.

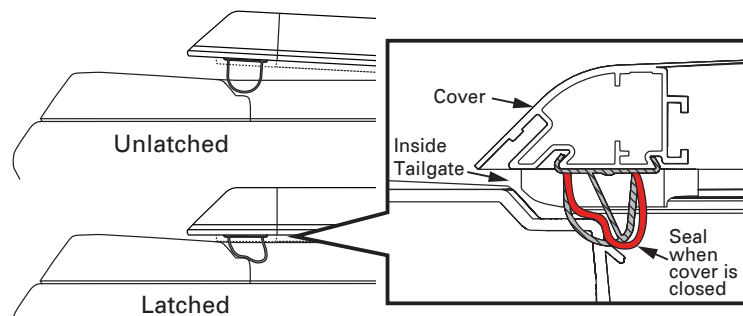


- 7** With the tailgate open and the front (cab) clamps secure, completely close the cover.

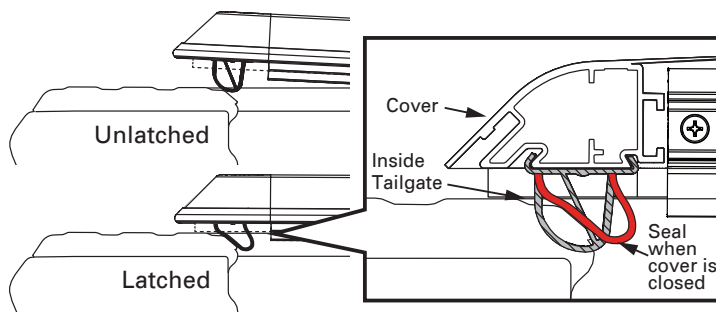


- 8 PROPER POSITION OF TONNEAU COVER.** Close the tailgate and unfold the cover. Check that the cover is parallel and square with the truck bed and bed rails. Adjust the cover until the bulb seal fits with the tailgate as shown. If not parallel or square, open the cover and loosen the cab clamps to reposition the cover.

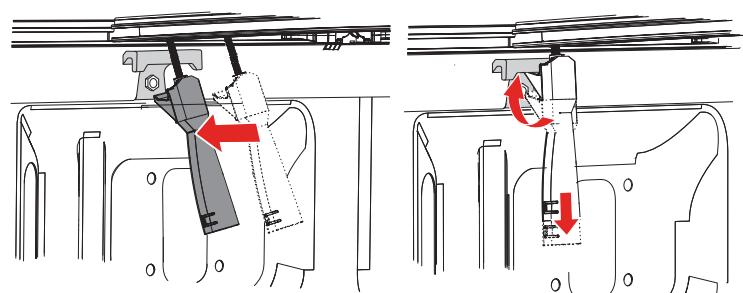

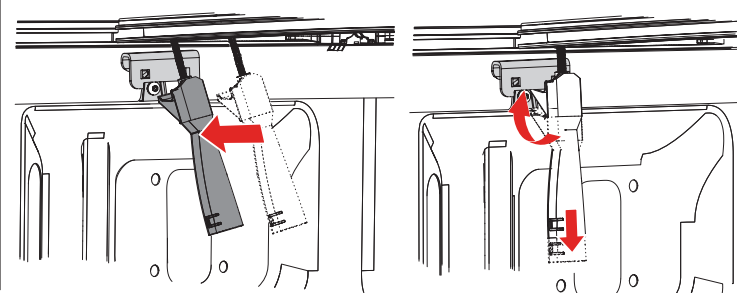


- 9 REAR CLAMP OPERATION.** The rear (tail) clamps are stowed in the cover rail. Rotate the clamp down and slide it to the truck bed rail. The clamps should be slid, at a slight angle, as far over to the rail as possible. Pull the clamps straight down and release them to hook under the bottom of the metal bracket. Always latch the clamps on both sides of the bed.

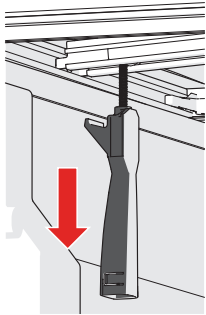

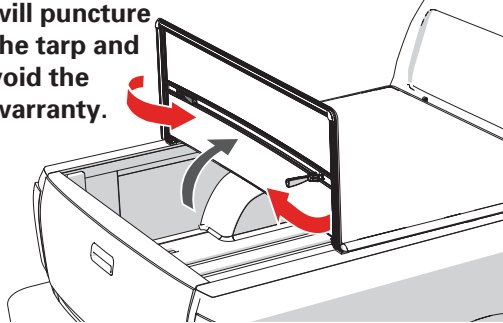


DRIVING WITH THE TONNEAU OPEN

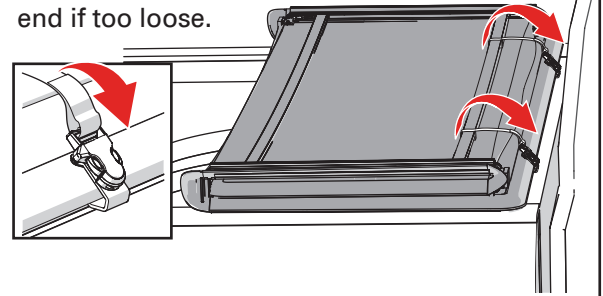
Release the rear clamps and fold the cover forward.



IMPORTANT: Before folding the second section of the cover, the rear clamps must be stowed into the rail to prevent damage to the fabric. **Failure to stow the handles will puncture the tarp and void the warranty.**



Securing the cover. To drive with the cover open, fold the cover forward to the cab and fasten BOTH straps in the middle section to the front rail. Check that the straps are tight, and pull the strap end if too loose.



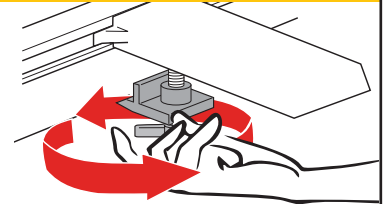
IMPORTANT

Re-tighten the front/cab clamps and tethers after the first week of driving the vehicle. Also periodically check the clamps and tethers to ensure they are secure.

Closed/Extended Position – Bed cover must be completely secured by all four (4) clamps.

Open/Folded Position – Bed cover must be completely folded up (all panels) and secured at the cab with the provided buckles straps and with both tethers attached.

Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.



Do NOT allow the vehicle to be towed backwards without first removing the cover from the vehicle.



Remove any snow or foreign matter before folding the bed cover.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

The cover, including as applicable any hardware kit (e.g., rails, clamps, and bows) and fabric, carries a limited lifetime warranty. This limited warranty is subject to the following terms:

WARRANTY COVERAGE

This tonneau cover is warranted against defects in materials or workmanship. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE

The warranty is to the initial consumer purchasing the tonneau cover and it is not transferrable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce the warranty rights.

WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Failure to follow these warnings and care instructions will void the warranty:

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only.
- Do not use conditioners that contain silicone or petroleum.
- Tonneau cover must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. When not fully extended, cover must be completely folded up and secured at the cab with the provided buckle straps and tethers attached. Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position..
- Check front/cab clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- To avoid potential damage to the cover, panel clamps/latches must be in their stored positions prior to opening/folding the panel.
- Do NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective tonneau cover, tarp, or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranted return, to substitute a newer model of tonneau cover having similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

WARRANTY PROCESS

A Return Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As a consumer, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective.

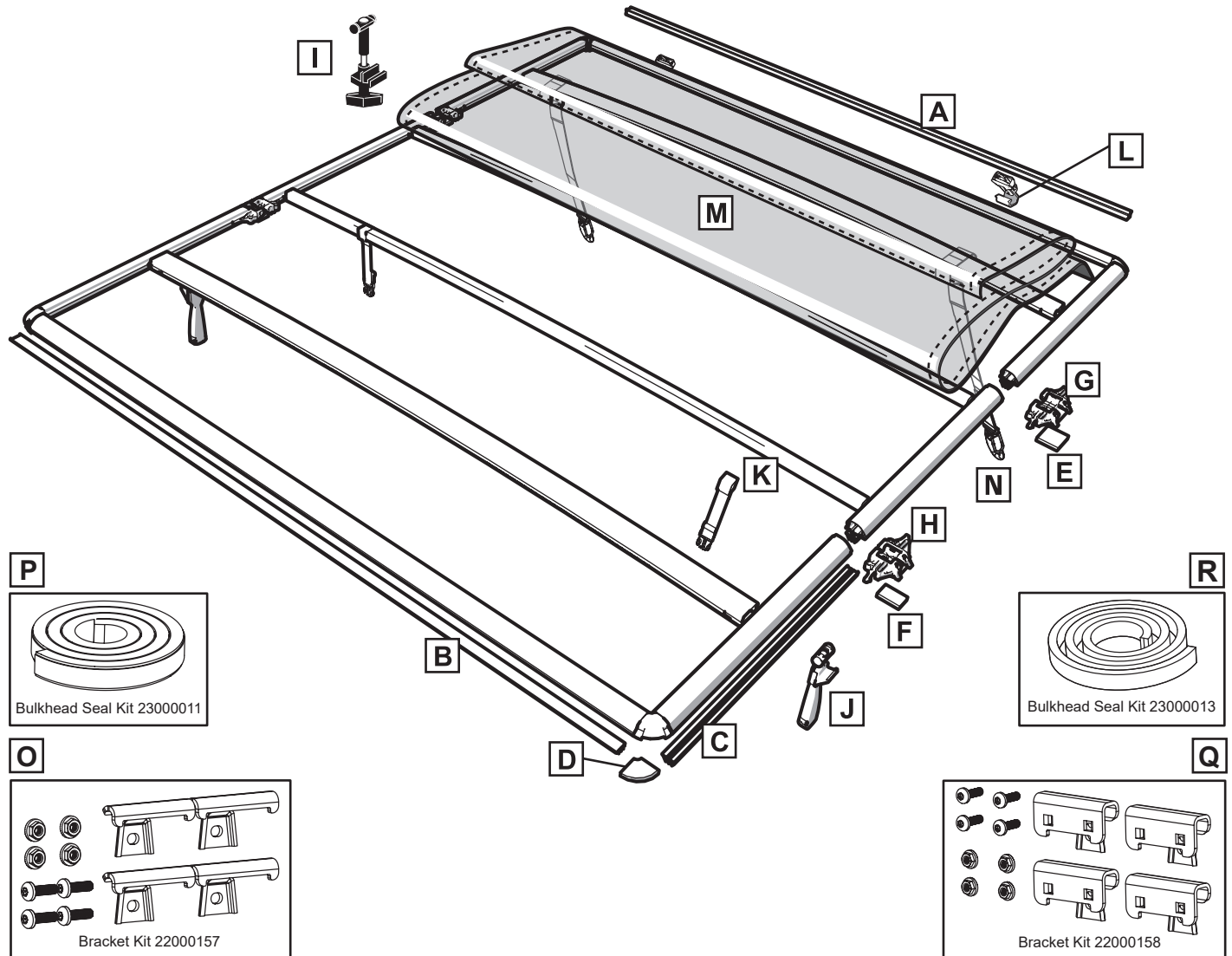
