- Periodically check all components for tightness.

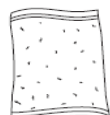

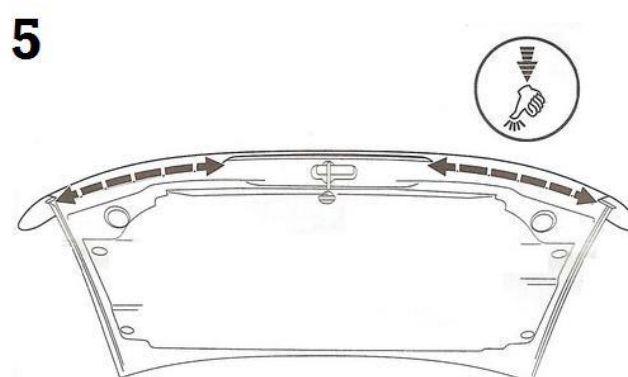
Preparation Before Painting / Installation

- Wash and dry your vehicle to remove any debris and/or dirt from the installation area.

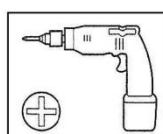
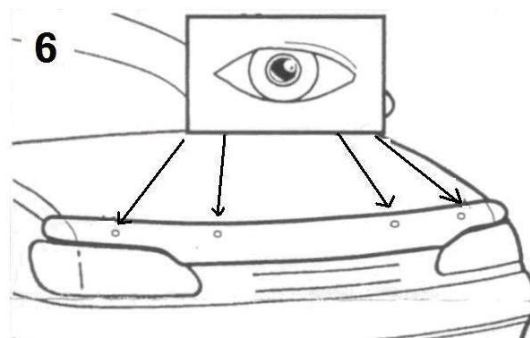
INSTALLATION STEPS



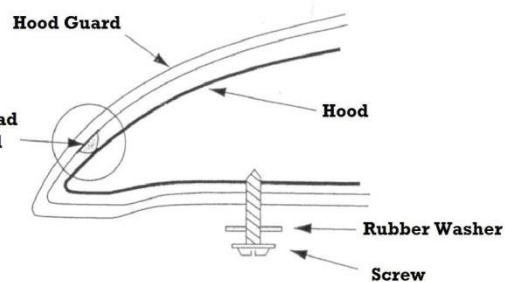
Center hood Guard and attach with exposed tape. Remove tape line



Apply pressure to tape flange



Note: rubber vibration pad should rest against hood



DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN SCREWS

PRODUCT CARE

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- **Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax.** Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.

FAQ's

1. **Mounting Bracket are not getting Installed properly.**

In some cases Illustration images shown in Installation manual may not be the exactly same as per actual vehicle images ,also if Driver / Passenger side mounting brackets are very identical in the design, suggest referring Parts Identification guide to avoid fitment issue.

2. **Products are thumping / rattling after installation.**

Please ensure that all required mounting brackets / hardware's are installed & tighten correctly. Suggest using white lithium / regular grease between the metal to metal contact surfaces.

3. **Missing / Excess Hardware.**

Recheck hardware count as per the part list.

4. **Product not installing properly.**

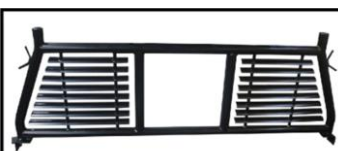
Ensure make model year, cab length and bed size of your vehicle is listed in the application. All installation steps are followed correctly.

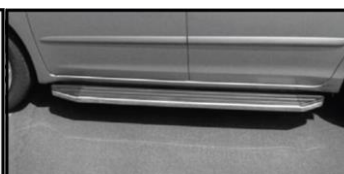
