



#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting from the drivers side rocker panel, remove the tape that covers the slot, that is located above the 2 hexagon holes. (A total of 3 taped slots per side should be removed). See **Figures 1 & 2.**
- 3. Place bolt plate onto the slotted hole as well as the M10 hex riv-cert onto the hexagon hole. (Before inserting stud / nut plate onto the slot place a square M10 Plastic Retainer on the stud portion of the plate to prevent the plate from falling in the slot, as shown in picture below). See **Figures 3 & 4.**












- 4. In order to properly mount the M8 riv-cert to the rocker panel, place the bracket tighten stud first then place washer with M8 bolt in the riv-cert and tighten. The riv-cert will expand and lock inside the rocker panel. See **Figure 5.**
- 5. Remove the M8 bolt and leave the top hardware in place loosely so that the stud can be moved.
- 6. Slide bracket slot to the M8 riv-cert and mount using (1) M8 Bolt, lock washer and flat washer. Remove the nut from the stud on the top of the bracket and turn the stud until the nut on the bottom aligns with the hexagon hole and the slot on the bracket. Using the M8 hardware loosely secure the bracket to the rocker panel. Using (1) M10 flat washer, (1) M10 hex nut, and (1) M10 lock washer finish loosely securing mounting brackets.
- 7. Locate a plastic bracket cover and loosely secure it to each of the brackets using the provided hardware: (2) M6 hex head cap screws, (4) M6 flat washers, and (2) M6 nylock nuts. Repeat for every bracket A/B. See **Figure 6**.
- 8. Repeat installation steps 1-7 on t rest of the driver and passenger bracket locations. **See Figure 7.** Refer to **Bracket Orientation** on **Page 6** for the location of each bracket.







- 9. Loosely Mount the side step on the driver side using supplied M10 hardware to the three mounting brackets that you have assembled. **See Figure 7-8.**
- 10. Repeat on the passenger side.










11. Starting on the driver side, mount the isolator kit to the lower and upper bed mounting bracket using M12 hardware (Items 21-22). Take the Isolator Mounting Bracket assembly and loosely install to the step bar. Locate the slot in the upper bed mounting bracket and using a 1/2" drill bit, drill a hole through the side of the bed channel and bottom of the bed channel. Remove metal debris. See **Figure 9-10.** Repeat on the passenger side.







- 12. Align the top bed mounting bracket with the 1/2" drilled holes. **Note:** It is necessary to keep the top isolator mount bracket aligned with the hole until the bolt of the M10 bolt / M8 nut plate is through. Locate M10 fish wire and insert end with spiral through the recently drilled 1/2" holes and out of vehicle frame. Then locate a M10 bolt / M8 nut plate (Item 16) and screw onto the fish wire. Pull the bolt / nut plate through each of the holes. See **Figure 11**.
- 13. Loosely secure the upper isolator bracket using the supplied M10 hardware. See Figure 12.








14. Align and adjust step bars as necessary. Tighten and torque all M10 hardware to 30 ft-lbs, M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs, M8 hardware to 15-18 ft lbs and M12 hardware to 65 ft-lbs. **See below to check for proper bracket orientation.**
